see the pyramids **ALONG THE NILE**

When Sally Stewart's son Willi invited her to join him on his trip to Egypt, she was surprised, but quickly said, "Yes!"

"I've always thought of traveling to Egypt because of the long history and culture," says Willi, 40, a seasoned traveler.

The Stewarts decided to travel in November, the least touristy time when fares are lower and it's less crowded. Also the temperatures are cooler, with highs averaging 78 degrees, compared to a 98-degree high last week in Cairo.

"Willi's the one who reads a lot of books and travel guides before he takes a trip," says his mother. He decided to use Bestways Tours and Safaris, which will customize an itinerary to fit the client.

"It was really nice to get off the plane in Cairo at 1:30 a.m. and have a guide meet you and take you to the hotel," says Sally.

The best part of the tour service, they say during an interview in the Stewarts' Portola Valley home, was providing tickets for train, bus and boat

travel and having a guide meet them at various destinations and take them to the hotel — not premiere accommodations but comfortable ones.

The Stewarts were disappointed that only a few guides could depart from the fast-paced, 30-minute format and translate the hieroglyphics on ancient monuments, for example. Their favorite guide was "Heba," a knowledgeable graduate student and feminist who took them to the pyramids.

Highlights of the trip were seeing the Great Pyramids, visiting the Aswan Dam and historic temples and tombs, and taking three days on their own, without guides. That's when they spent hours at the huge Egyptian Museum, explored crowded and bustling Cairo, and discovered how to use the subway system to get off the beaten track.

"It was enlightening to walk down the streets, get lost, see all kinds of people, including a man with a manicured beard reading the Quiran," says Willi.

People were friendly and very willing to help, the Stewarts say. The owner of a street shop gave them a flower and a bookmark on their last night in Cairo.

After a week in Egypt, Sally and Willi decided to say they were Canadians to reduce pleas from people wanting money.

The Stewarts did some "touristy things," but they didn't

ride a camel across the desert sand. They visited major sites and attractions at Karnak and Luxor, and the tomb of Ramses II at Abu Simbel that dates to the 1250s B.C.

They took an overnight train from Cairo to see the massive Aswan Dam. They wish they had spent another day in Aswan to see the Nubian Museum, which preserves the history and relics of the Nubian tribes that once formed a powerful empire between Egypt and Ethiopia from the 6th through the 14th centuries. Their land was flooded with the construction of the Aswan Dam.

The Stewarts took a boat trip down the Nile, stopping at Luxor and Karnak to visit the temples, and the Valley of Kings, where burial places are still being discovered.

After visiting Luxor Palace, they met a group of American soldiers on leave from their assignment on the Sinai Peninsula. The soldiers asked the Stewarts to take their

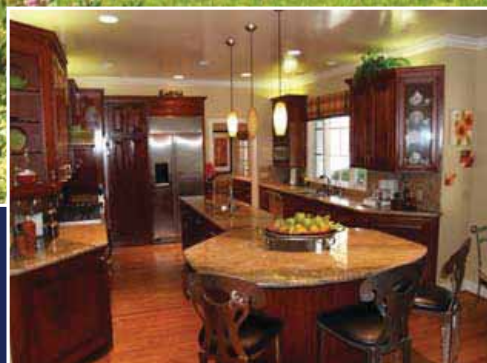

picture. One of them even knew about Portola Valley.

A special treat for the duo — both accomplished sailors — was sailing on the Nile in a “felucca,” a small, narrow sailboat.

While cruising on a larger boat, they passed miles of verdant agricultural fields.

Sally and Willi were amazed to see the temple built for the only female pharaoh, Hatshepsut. Later pharaohs tried to destroy or deface all images of her. (When they returned home, the Stewarts enjoyed the exhibit about Hatshepsut at the DeYoung Museum in San Francisco.)

One night they stayed in a tourist hotel, filled with only Russian guests. The breakfast was a surprise: all sugared cereals — Lucky Charms and Cocoa Puffs — with a large bowl of chocolate syrup for the topping.

The food wasn’t “uppermost” on their list. They avoided salads and ate a lot of chicken. Willi liked the bread best of all. Egyptian coffee is like “sludge,” says Sally. They did find an Egyptian

fast-food franchise that dished up a variety of pastas.

Willi found Internet cafes where he could e-mail friends about his trip. While he keeps a journal at home, he uses e-mails during his travels as his trip diary. He works in the information services department for Santa Clara County and lives in San Jose.

“If I went back to Egypt, I would do it (without guides),” says Willi, although he acknowledged guides are necessary to getting around on one’s first trip. “Part of my fun is the discovery process, taking the day walking and exploring.” ■

At home with art

Couple opens first joint exhibit this week

Step into the Portola Valley living room of Rich Bielsker and Gloria Strongin and you've stepped into an art gallery.

In fact, they've named the room The Galleria — a space reflecting a range of her color-intense paintings; his sculpted bears, cougars and gorillas; and richly textured collaborative works by the married couple.

"Go ahead — you can touch," Mr. Bielsker tells a visitor intrigued by the texture of one of his pieces. "That's why I love sculpture: You can touch."

The artists don't have far to travel to The Galleria when they finish their work. Their studios are located in the back wing of their spacious Westridge home. It's a cosy, vibrant environment, an enterprise they call Windy Hill Fine Art in recognition of the view from their studios of Windy Hill Open Space Reserve.

For the last six months, Ms. Strongin and Mr. Bielsker have been working in their adjacent studios 10 to 14 hours a day preparing for a two-person exhibit opening June 1 in Redwood City.

The show, running through June 30, is at the Redwood City Art Center, 2625 Broadway #101,

and an artists' reception is set for 7 to 9 p.m. Friday, June 2.

Ms. Strongin, a retired elementary school teacher, works in oil on canvas and color pencil on paper — mostly landscapes and wildlife.

A retired businessman and computer programmer, Mr. Bielsker shapes his figures out of polymer clay, alabaster, sometimes even foam. He coats some of his pieces with acrylic modeling paste, giving them a hard surface that can take a beating, or the sweep of hands of those taking him up on his offer: "You can touch."

Their collaborations are essentially a hybrid of their individual media — for example, a landscape featuring a three-dimensional tree on canvas with an oil-painted background.

Common ground

Both have been engaged in their art for decades, though it

would take some time to join forces.

For Ms. Strongin, painting was something she squeezed in at the end of her busy workday in the classroom and at home — "something I enjoyed doing while the kids were asleep."

Mr. Bielsker recalls that he started "dabbling" in painting to help him cope with the high stress of owning a bookstore in Southern California in the 1970s and early 1980s. His artistic leaning was toward dimension, however, and he ultimately turned to sculpture.

They were both widowed when they met at a Sierra Club function in 1991. The painter and the sculptor discovered an expanse of common ground — a love of the natural world and a commitment to artistic

expression.

In addition to the physical space they now share, the cou-

ple's common ground includes four grandchildren and Mensch, a chocolate Labrador. ▀

FOCUS!

The focusing process begins with the cornea (the transparent layer of the eye) bending, or "refracting," incoming light at an angle determined by the cornea's fixed curvature. The eye lens then fine-tunes the focus, further refracting the light. Unlike the cornea, the lens is flexible. Its curvature changes with the help of the ciliary muscles. When the eye focuses on a distant object, the ciliary muscles relax and the lens flattens. Shifting the focus closer makes the ciliary muscles contract, which thickens the lens and renders it more curved in the middle. This "accommodation" occurs naturally, until the lens begins to harden and lose its flexibility around age 40. Then, reading glasses may become necessary.
