## A desire to complement good food and a bent for science set Mark Chamness on the home winemaker's path

This is a milestone year for Mark Chamness, a Menlo Park software engineer and home winemaker.

Three months ago, bright-eyed Ella made first-time parents of Mark, 36, and his wife, Lara. And, in just about three months from now, Mr. Chamness will harvest the grapes from 160 vines he planted about four years ago, allowing him for the first time to make wine from his own grapes.

This year also marks the 10th anniversary of the day he first threw a packet of yeast into a fermentation bucket full of Black Rose grapes from his parents' Central Valley farm — grapes he had crushed with

his hands.

He has certainly come a long way.

### The Chamness home winery

Mark and Lara Chamness' West Menlo Park garage looks a lot like yours and mine — if you're looking only at one wall. But turn your gaze away from the pegboard of hammers, pliers and other handy tools and you'll notice a trio of oak barrels, an oak-slatted Italian wine press, glass carboys hopeful with fermenting wine, and a gleaming stainless steel tank.

The scene isn't exactly what Mr. Chamness envisioned for his small garage 10 years ago. Although he was interested in wine and how it's made, he originally started off exploring the ins

and outs of home beer-making.

That pursuit fizzled out fairly quickly, though. "I made a batch of beer, and I thought it was a lot of work," he recalls.

So he tried his hand with the grape, finding the process of winemaking much more straightforward and

satisfying, he says.

Making wine was perhaps a better match for Mr. Chamness. As a college student, studying physics at the California Institute of Technology, then as a doctoral candidate at Brown University, one way in which he indulged his interest in food was buying cookbooks. He

was especially taken with a seafood book that also made wine recommendations.

He began exploring wine as a complement to food, but ever the curious scientist, he felt he had to understand the process by which the grape was transformed and wine developed in the seemingly mysterious ways it did.

"I knew I could understand it if I used my hands. ...that I would really understand the process," he explains. Begun as an educational pursuit, winemaking proved to be so enjoyable that he began investing more each year in and equipment and research time.

The complementary nature of wine and food is still the guiding principle at the Chamness home winery. Non-commercial winemakers can decide what they want from their wine, he says, adding, "I try to make wine that's good with food."

The winemaking bug took hold of him so firmly that

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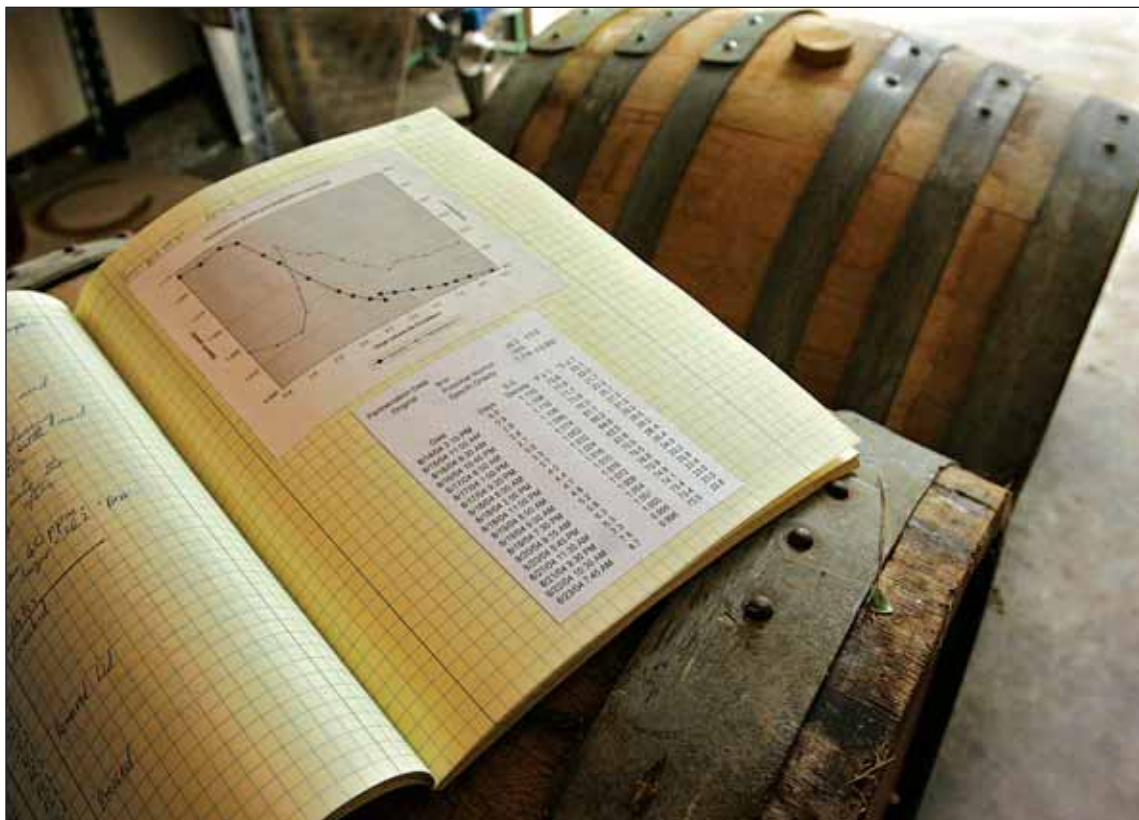

he decided to grow his own grapes, and in 2002 planted vines — 80 red-grape and 80 white — on his mother-in-law's Alamo property. He acquired the Rhone varietals from Tablas Creek Vineyard in Paso Robles.

The vines have reached maturity this year, so he will harvest his syrah, grenache, mourvedre, viognier, roussanne and marsanne grapes for crushing this fall.

In addition to buying the vines from Tablas Creek, Mr. Chamness tapped into some of the expertise of the winemaker by attending a seminar. The winery follows the venerable Chateaneuf du Pape tradition of blending varietals. Mr. Chamness also follows Tablas Creek's practice of native-yeast fermentation, whereby

natural yeast is allowed to develop in the grape juice, or must — a technique considered risky by commercial California winemakers but widely practiced in Europe, he says.

Planting his own vines was not a huge leap for the son of San Joaquin Valley farmers.

By age 12, he was already driving a tractor, helping his parents tend the land that produced grapes and kiwis.

Asked if he was ready to quit his day gig and start producing wine commercially, Mr. Chamness replies: "Starting a winery is a great way to lose a lot of money. My goal is to

searching for gastronomic rewards. Like solving a difficult physics problem, there's a challenge to making great wine. I enjoy working on very difficult puzzles."

Buying grapes from other growers while his own vines mature, Mr. Chamness has made a range of wines, including sangiovese, merlot, zinfandel and zinfandel rose, pinot noir, cabernet, and a white dessert wine called vin de paille — French for "straw wine," so called because of the process of drying the grapes indoors on straw mats.

The cabernet and chardonnay wines he made in 1998 were served at his and Lara's 2001 wedding. This year, his sangiovese took a silver medal in the Orange County Wine Society's Homewine Competition.

Mr. Chamness belongs to the Peninsula Wine-tasting Group, made up of local wine enthusiasts and collectors, and the Bay Area Winemaking Association, which is a home winemaking group that anyone can join. He was recently invited to be a guest speaker at a meeting of the latter group.

### A few pointers

So what advice would he give to people interested in

produce and sell 100 cases of wine to local restaurants and retailers. That would be enough for the hobby to break even."

But even if that doesn't happen, he's likely to continue making wine.

"I don't expect any financial rewards," he says. "I'm

starting their own home winemaking enterprise?

"Educate yourself," he says. "Get a book on winemaking or subscribe to Winemaker Magazine. Join a winemaking group, either locally or online."

Also, he advises, start small. "Visit the local winemaking store. They can suggest the minimum amount of equipment you'll need and offer rentals on larger equipment."

Finally, when seeking grapes from vineyard own-

ers, "buy expensive grapes. Many beginning winemakers often believe they can turn lead into gold, but they will always be disappointed. The best wine comes from the best grapes."

In addition to the arrival of baby Ella and the coming harvest of his Alamo vines for his own winemaking enterprise, Mr. Chamness will add another "first" to his list this year. He will begin writing a newspaper column on wine and local winemakers — a column that will appear regularly in the Almanac's monthly Food & Drink section. ■

## Local playwright's work opens Bus Barn summer festival

When Krista Knight moved from her Portola Valley home to Brown University in 2002, it was to study neuroscience. But somewhere along the way, she decided to dramatically alter her approach to life.

That's because she came to realize that "instead of studying the world as I did in the sciences, I could create worlds on stage," she says.

Local theater-goers can take a peek into one of the worlds she has created — the world of three sisters living in a nowhere town in Utah — when her play, "Moscow, Utah," kicks off the Bus Barn Stage Company's summer festival on Thursday, July 6.

The Los Altos-based theater company features new work — in staged readings — of Bay Area playwrights in the annual festival, which runs through July 30.

Ms. Knight, now pursuing a master's degree in performance studies at New York University, tells the story of Janel and Irene Stevens, telephone operators living in a stiflingly small Utah town and caring for their sister Laura, described as "a victim of a zoo accident." The two sisters long to move to the much larger town of Moscow, and away from the burden of caring for Laura.

When talking about her play to friends, Ms. Knight says: "I describe it as an adaptation of Chekhov's 'Three Sisters.' ... In writing this play, I was interested in the intersection between desperation and stagnation, claus-

trophobia and intense loneliness, suffocation and abandonment — and what happens when this intersection takes place in one room, between three sisters."

Described by Bus Barn as a dramatic comedy in two acts, "Moscow, Utah" will be presented as a staged reading July 6 through 8 at 8 p.m. The theater is at 97 Hillview Ave. in Los Altos.

### Theatrical past

Involved in theater from the time she was very young and participated in "Hot Dog Theater" in Palo Alto, Ms. Knight never really abandoned her love for the stage, even when she decided to study neuroscience.

The daughter of 30-year Portola Valley residents Kirk and Virginia Knight, she attended Ormondale Elementary School in Portola Valley, then Menlo middle and high schools in Atherton. In high school, she won the key role of Estragon in

Beckett's "Waiting for Godot."

Once Ms. Knight arrived at Brown, "I was introduced ... to teachers who brought to life the danger and the excitement, the possibility and the plasticity of writing plays," she writes in an e-mail to the Almanac.

She decided to major in English and theater, and she just finished her honors thesis in playwriting, studying with Paula Vogel, who won a Pulitzer Prize for her play, "How I Learned to Drive."

Ms. Knight wrote "Moscow, Utah" during her junior semester abroad in London, where she studied with the Writers' Guild of Great Britain, she says. It was given a staged reading last month at the Playwrights' Center of San Francisco, and in March, it was a finalist in the Actors' Theatre of Santa Cruz Full-Length Play Competition.

### Bus Barn festival

In addition to "Moscow, Utah," the Bus Barn summer festival will feature "An Evening of Shorts," three one-act plays, from July 13 to 15. The one-acts are "Red Telescope" by Trevor Allen, "Tea in Miami" by Jeff Carter, and "Leave a Message" by Fred Hartman.

Next up, from July 20 to 22, is "Red House" by Ignacio Zulueta, a fictional treatment of the lives of legendary Victorian artists William Morris, Dante Rossetti and Edward Burne-Jones.

Closing the festival July 27, 28 and 30 is "Still in the Game" by Jan August.

Tickets are \$12 general, and \$10 for subscribers. A festival pass is available for \$40. For information, call 941-0551, or log on at busbarn.org. ■

A Wednesday story hour takes place each week at 10 a.m. for children up to 18 months, and at 11 a.m. for toddlers 18 months and up.

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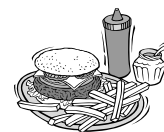
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# Teachers, staff honored for 'enthusiasm, passion'
