

# Learning by example

When Jim Kelly speaks, he puts a thumb over the hole in his throat. Mr. Kelly, 86, possesses vigor belying the ravages of the throat cancer that took away his voice. When he speaks in a froggy voice, pressing his thumb over the vinyl valve in his neck, the class of sophomores at Menlo-Atherton High School listen.

Mr. Kelly and his colleague John Ready are part of the Lost Chord, a nonprofit organization dedicated to the rehabilitation of laryngectomees — people who have had their vocal cords removed. Thirty clubs in California, including chapters in Santa Clara and San Mateo counties, help people learn to speak again and deal with the psychosocial aspects of the surgery.

Lost Chord members such as Jim Kelly and John Ready give voice to the perils of smoking by lecturing to students in both counties. Mr. Kelly has appeared at M-A High for the last decade, at the invitation of safety education teacher Ken Gradiska. Last year alone, he and his long-time speaking partner, Jack

## Laryngectomees graphically demonstrate the perils of smoking

Armas, spoke to 1,600 students, Mr. Kelly said.

The eye-opening presentation is a graphic window into the harm smoking causes.

On a Friday last spring, the two men spent the afternoon talking to classes of sophomores, juniors and seniors at M-A.

Mr. Kelly started smoking at age 23 during World War II, when the Army passed out thousands of cartons of cigarettes to GIs. “America had a smoking culture then. More than half of the men in my army outfit were smokers,” he told the students.

He stopped smoking in 1985. “Four years later, bingo — cancer,” he said.

“Why did I smoke? I smoked pipes. I thought they were extra-cool,” he said, honing in on the mind-set of teens.

“Men who did creative things smoked pipes — men who were writers,” said Mr. Kelly, a journalist for 40 years.

The “cool” wore off for him as the years went by; and when cancer struck, he had to do some serious re-evaluation, he said.

“I will never forget waking up after the operation. I had a spaghetti of tubes coming out of me. I opened my mouth and I couldn’t make a sound. That’s when it hit me — what I did to myself with smoking,” he said.

Mr. Kelly said he felt guilty, too. He had exposed his wife and children to 40 years of second-hand smoke.

When he got home, he looked at the headliner of the family’s Volkswagen van, a tangible measure of the effects of tobacco smoke.

“Over the years, it turned from cream-color to brown from the tobacco,” he said.

Mr. Ready began smoking at age 15 and enjoyed cigarettes for 16 years, burning through a

half-pack a day. When his cancer appeared 10 years ago, he was 41 years old with a wife and four children, ages 12, 9, 27 months and 13 months.

His cancer diagnosis had come 10 years after he quit smoking. "I thought quitting smoking meant I was done," he said.

Mr. Ready has been cancer-free for 10 years — a miraculous number in his estimation, since he had a mere 30 percent chance of surviving.

"There's really no reason for us to be around," he said.

Asked by a student what he would do if he caught one of his children smoking, Mr. Ready said his daughter had already been caught in the act.

"I said, 'Why don't you keep this up, and we can be a father-daughter laryngectomee team and go on the road?'"

"She burst out crying and stopped smoking. When she caught her brother, she got all over his case," he said.

Mr. Ready wears an extra valve that acts like the thumb and opens and closes, allowing him to speak without holding a hand to his neck. He volunteers at Stanford Hospital, helping people who have just undergone laryngectomies learn to cope with the changes and to speak through their stoma — the name for the hole in the throat.

He pointed to a paper Stanford visitor badge on his chest. Earlier

that day, he visited a 16-year-old boy at the hospital who had a laryngectomy, the result of his father's second-hand smoke.

"He should be sitting in an empty chair in his sophomore class," Mr. Ready said, pointing to a vacant space in the classroom, "instead of sitting in Stanford hospital getting radiation therapy."

The youngest person to have a laryngectomy is a 10-day-old infant, Mr. Ready said.

"His mom smoked through the entire pregnancy. That baby never had a chance," he said.

The baby survived and grew up to speak almost flawlessly through his stoma, Mr. Kelly added.

As the class bell buzzed, several students stopped to shake

hands with the two speakers.

Did their talk persuade the students to shun or give up smoking?

Matt, a junior, smokes a couple of cigarettes a day. He's working on quitting now, and said that the presentation persuaded him not to smoke.

Yuly, 16, said she doesn't smoke. After experiencing the Lost Chord presentation, she isn't likely to start, she added.

How do the men know they've been effective?

"You can see it in their eyes," Mr. Ready said.

"When they come up and shake our hands afterwards," Mr. Kelly added, "then we know."

## Volunteers sought for studies on flu vaccine, depression

The Stanford Medical Center is looking for volunteers for one study that aims to improve the availability of flu vaccines and another that will investigate the biological risk factors for depression.

Researchers in the study on depression are examining mother-daughter pairs in hopes of learning more about the causes of the illness. It appears to have a strong genetic component; 40 to 60 percent of girls with depressed mothers develop a depressive disorder before they reach adulthood,

according to a Stanford news release.

The study will compare data from daughters of depressed mothers with that from daughters of mothers who don't suffer from depression. It will monitor both groups at 18-month intervals to see how girls.

Participating mothers must either have had recurrent, clinically significant depression, or must have no history of psychiatric issues. Daughters must be between the ages of 9 and 14.

The other study will evaluate an influenza vaccine manufac-

tured in Australia.

Sponsored by the National Institute of Allergy and Infectious Diseases, the study aims to help prevent a vaccine shortage similar to the one that occurred in 2004, when safety concerns forced one of the two manufacturers of an FDA-licensed vaccine to withdraw its product from the market. As a result, nearly half of the normal supply was not available.

The Australian vaccine is manufactured by CSL Limited, which would supply about one-fifth of the United States' 100 million doses in the 2007-08 season, if the vaccine is approved.

Volunteers must make three visits to the lab; they must be between the ages of 18 and 64 and in good health.

## Free program encourages active living for those over 50

The San Mateo County Health Department is offering a free six-month program geared toward sedentary adults over age 50.

The program works with adults to motivate and guide them in setting weekly activity goals. Participants will receive a pedometer; ideas on how to make exercise fun, safe and

affordable; and materials to help them meet their exercise goals.

To qualify, a person must be a county resident age 50 or older, and exercise infrequently or not at all.

Research shows that healthful lifestyles have a greater impact than genetic factors in helping older adults avoid the dete-

rioration associated with aging, county health officials note. With regular exercise, adults can reduce the risk of heart disease, arthritis, diabetes and stroke, increase energy, improve sleep and, ultimately, improve their overall health.

# Suffering from low back pain? Here are some tips to cope

Low back pain, known as lumbago, is more common than one may think. It ranges from a dull nagging ache to a sharp, breathtaking pain with associated numbness and tingling in the legs.

About 85 percent of our population will suffer disabling low back pain at least once in their lives.

I'm still amazed by the number of people who come through the office doors in discomfort. Daily, I hear, "How did this happen?" "I exercise!" and "How can I prevent this from happening again?"

With this in mind, I hope this article will help all those who are suffering or have suffered from low back pain.

One of man's strongest structures in architectural design is the bridge or arch. Our spine is modeled similarly, but with three main curves. When we have bad posture and move away from the neutral curvature of our spine, our bodies function in a compromised state. Our muscles not only work harder, but stress to our joints increases and symptoms of discomfort such as low back pain can surface.

Here are my five tips on how to prevent and manage low back pain:

■ Ice first. I cannot begin to tell you how many times I have

heard, "Well my mom told me to put heat on it." Always start with ice for 15 to 20 minutes, with a thin layer of paper towel to protect the skin. The ice serves to decrease inflammation and promotes healing. The frequency with which you ice will depend on the severity of your injury.

■ Maintain good posture. I often advise my patients to take three small post-it notes and put them in the most common rooms or places that they visit throughout the day. For example: the car, the office, the bathroom. The post-it notes act as cues or a reminder to "sit up straight, shoulders back and down, and tuck your chin back."

Another postural suggestion is to use a lumbar support when sitting. Placing a rolled up towel behind your waistline can help relieve a lot of stress to the low back while sitting. A rolled-up jacket also works well for the car and airplanes.

■ Continuing to exercise is important but don't do what hurts! Proper exercise can help speed recovery and prevent and reduce risk of low back pain. It is better to continue with regular activity because bed rest can cause muscles to seize, often worsening low back pain. By the same token,

it is important not to further injure your back. For example, if you are experiencing a burning pain in your low back while performing sit-ups, don't do them!

■ Don't hold your breath when you sneeze! Holding your breath during a sneeze increases the pressure within your spine and can potentially cause your vertebral disc to bulge or herniated towards a nerve.

■ Have your mattress checked to ensure that it is supportive. Proper rejuvenation to your back will occur if there is no stress to it while you sleep. Sleeping on your back or side are the best positions. When sleeping on your back, place a pillow under your legs to relax the low back muscles. When on your side, place a pillow in between your legs to avoid twisting of the low back.

Low back pain affects both our work and play. If your back begins to feel tired at work, have your work area ergonomically evaluated. If you are suffering from low back discomfort extending for more than a week, have it carefully evaluated by a professional. Your chiropractor, physiotherapist or family physician will be able to help you.

Preventive measures greatly reduce the risk of recurring low back pain. Recognizing bodily cues and making simple lifestyle changes not only reduce that risk, but can enhance your overall health.
