Keeping it fun

TRAINING AND SOCIALIZING A WINNING MIX FOR TRIATHLON CHAMP HOLLY NYBO

Competitors tend to dislike running with Holly Nybo, mostly because they can't keep up with her, but also because she's just so friendly.

"I've had a few people say, 'Stop talking to me!' during races," Ms. Nybo admits with a laugh. "But it's so boring otherwise."

Ms. Nybo, a resident of Portola Valley, won the U.S. national triathlon champion in the 40-44 age group three of the last four years. She started to compete in triathlons in 1989 while living in San Diego, primarily because it would give her a chance to socialize with many of her friends who competed.

She won the first race she entered

— in Big Bear, California — surprising her more experienced friends. Seventeen years later, Ms. Nybo has risen to the upper echelon of international

age-group triathlon competition, using the same approach that got her started: keep having fun.

Most recently, she took home a first-place finish in the 40-44 year-old age group at the USA Triathlon Age Group National Championships on July 10 in Smithville Lake, Missouri, a town near Kansas City.

Now married and the mother of two, Ms. Nybo doesn't view triathlon competition — which involves running, swimming and bicycling — as her top priority. She still sees it as a social activity, often exercising with other moms who have the same schedule and can keep up with her.

"Instead of going out for coffee or lunch, we'll go for a bike ride," she says.

She also uses it as an opportunity to travel, planning family vacations

around competitions. She traveled with her family to the age-group World Championships in New Zealand in 2003, finishing first in the 40-44 division and fourth overall. Last year, the competition took her to Honolulu, where she placed second in her age group.

Competitive streak

Though Ms. Nybo unquestionably enjoys running triathlons, her competitors aren't fooled by her calm, friendly demeanor: Beneath it lies a serious competitive streak. Though hip and pelvis injuries kept her out of triathlon competition for the first half of this year — the lingering effects of childbirth and not enough stretching, she says

— she still decided to run at nationals, and had to use some extra juice to beat out another runner by seven seconds at the end of the race.

“I could tell that I hadn’t been doing the training I like to do, but my rivals weren’t (racing at nationals),” she says. “I was in first until a girl (Cassie McWilliam from New York) caught me with a half mile to go. I said, I can’t let this girl beat me! And I held her off.”

The victory qualified Ms. Nybo for this year’s World Championships, which will be held in Lausanne, Switzerland, in early September. She decided that she would make the trip only after her friend Kari Rust, whom Ms. Nybo mentors, qualified in the 35-39 age group.

Ms. Nybo swam competitively as a student at Gunn High School in Palo Alto, but running has evolved into her favorite of the three sports. She usually makes up time in that event, the final leg, chasing down two competitors during the run to win in New Zealand.

Six years after her first triathlon race, Ms. Nybo began to compete in the Ironman, which consists of a 2.4-mile swim, a 112-mile bike ride, and a 26-mile run.

The birth of her second child put an end to her days as an Ironman racer, but Ms. Nybo still tries to exercise nine times a week when she’s healthy — three times per sport. She also teaches a master’s swim class at De Anza College twice a week.

Advice

As a former personal trainer, Ms. Nybo says that she would advise anyone new to triathlons, or exercising in general, to begin gradually and try to enjoy it.

“Most people tend to run way too far the first time,” she says. “I’d tell them to slow down: Believe me, you’ll be sore tomorrow.”

Though her 7-year-old-son Don has competed in short triathlons for children, Ms. Nybo says that

she would rather send him out to bike around a field a couple of times than train him seriously.

As it does for many people, exercise also serves a practical purpose for Ms. Nybo.

“I’m not that much fun to be around when I don’t do it,” she says with a wry smile.

Her free time is understandably limited, but she enjoys reading and gardening when she’s not training or playing with her kids. She has also joined an adult softball league with her husband and is “learning how not to throw like a girl,” she says.

And her family has hosted a French exchange student for the last two years; the student helps to look after the kids.

How much longer does Ms. Nybo plan to compete in triathlons?

“I’ll keep doing it as long as it’s still fun,” she says. “Obviously, it helps when you win. I still enjoy it.” ■

Health department warns: Don’t eat raw oysters

It’s generally not safe to eat raw oysters during summer months, but consumers should be especially careful this summer, the San Mateo County Health Department cautioned last week — especially if the oysters are from the Pacific Northwest.

Brian Zamora, the county’s director of public health, issued an advisory news release in response to five recent cases of gastrointestinal illness in the county believed to have been caused by eating raw oysters.

This summer, oysters from the

Pacific Northwest have caused an unusual amount of illnesses, according to the release. The health department is encouraging consumers who have purchased oysters from that area to return them, and advised retailers to send oysters from the region back to their original vendor if they were purchased after July 13.

The department said that the illnesses were probably caused by a naturally occurring bacterium called *Vibrio*, most prevalent during hot summer months.

It added that oysters usually don’t cause life-threatening illnesses, but that severe illness can occur in people with weakened immune systems. The symptoms may include watery diarrhea, abdominal cramping, nausea, vomiting, fever and chills. They usually occur within 24 hours of eating the oysters and generally don’t last for more than three days.

Undercooked oysters may also pose a health risk if they are lightly steamed, marinated or prepared as Rockefeller, the department advised.

dance with the timeline above, the levy of the UUT shall terminate on December 31 of that year, unless placed on the ballot and approved by a majority vote.

Allows for temporary reduction or suspension of the tax for up to twelve months by a simple majority vote of the Council.

Provides an exemption for low income residents who qualify for the PG&E CARE program for the UUT on gas and electricity.

Allows an exemption for solar electricity generation or co-generation for personal/on-site use and states that the exemption will be in place for six years, at which point the Council will review the exemption and determine whether to extend it or terminate it.

Sets forth procedures for implementation, administration and enforcement of the UUT.

NOTICE OF ADOPTION**

The City Council of Menlo Park adopted Ordinance No. 950 at its regular meeting City Council meeting of August 1, 2006. The Ordinance was introduced on July 25, 2006, and adopted on August 1, 2006. Council Members unanimously voted in favor of (Jellins, Ferguson, Cohen, Duboc and Winkler). The Ordinance shall be effective ten (10) days after a majority of the voters voting thereon approve Chapter 3.14 and the results of the election are declared by the City Council. The Ordinance is summarized as follows:

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MENLO PARK ADOPTING A UTILITY USERS TAX

A new Chapter 3.14 (Utility Users Tax) of the City of Menlo Park Municipal Code is hereby adopted, which chapter adopts a utility users tax (hereinafter "UUT"), which would become effective only if approved by a majority of voters at the November 7, 2006, election. The Ordinance:

- Sets a UUT at 3.5% for electric, gas and water utilities.
- Sets a UUT at 2.5% for communications utilities (phone and video).
- Sets the maximum tax payment for electric, gas and water utility users at \$12,000 per year for a service user at one location.
- States that the Council shall review the need for the UUT no later than June 30, 2008, and every two years thereafter and shall by a 2/3 vote make the findings that the UUT is necessary for the City's financial health. If the Council fails to make such findings in accor-

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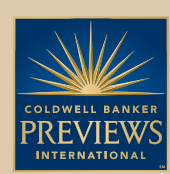

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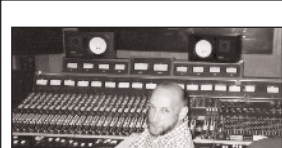
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

**A GENERAL REGULATION AMENDING GENERAL REGULATION NO. 58
"A GENERAL REGULATION ADOPTING CODE OF GENERAL REGULATIONS"**

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED BY THE District Board of West Bay Sanitary District that General Regulation No. 58, "A General Regulation Adopting Code of General Regulations," passed and approved on November 27, 1982, as heretofore amended, is hereby further amended as follows:

Section 1.
Article IX, Section 900 (03) (A) and (B) are hereby amended in their entirety to read as follows:
(03) Residential Customers Sewer Service Charge.

(A) Residential Customers Rate.

The flat rate sewer service charge for fiscal year July 1, 2005 through June 30, 2006 for residential customers shall be Two Hundred Ninety Dollars and no cents (\$290.00).

The flat rate sewer service charge for fiscal year July 1, 2006 through June 30, 2007 for residential customers shall be Three Hundred Ten Dollars and no cents (\$310.00) plus Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) per Single Family Residence.

The flat rate sewer service charge for fiscal year July 1, 2007 through June 30, 2008 for residential customers shall be Three Hundred Thirty Dollars and no cents (\$330.00) plus Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) per Single Family Residence.

The flat rate sewer service charge for fiscal year July 1, 2008 through June 30, 2009 for residential customers shall be Three Hundred Fifty Dollars and no cents (\$350.00) plus Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) per Single Family Residence.

The flat rate sewer service charge for fiscal year July 1, 2009 through June 30, 2010 for residential customers shall be Three Hundred Seventy Dollars and no cents (\$370.00) plus Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) per Single Family Residence.

(B) STEP System Residential Customers Rate.

The sewer service charge for residential customers served by a Septic Tank Effluent Pumping System (STEP System) for fiscal year July 1, 2005 through June 30, 2006 shall be Four Hundred Ninety Four Dollars and no cents (\$494.00).

The sewer service charge for residential customers served by a Septic Tank Effluent Pumping System (STEP System) for fiscal year July 1, 2006 through June 30, 2007 shall be Five Hundred Fourteen Dollars and no cents (\$514.00) plus Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) per Single Family Residence.

The sewer service charge for residential customers served by a Septic Tank Effluent Pumping System (STEP System) for fiscal year July 1, 2007 through June 30, 2008 shall be Five Hundred Thirty Four Dollars and no cents (\$534.00) plus Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) per Single Family Residence.

The sewer service charge for residential customers served by a Septic Tank Effluent Pumping System (STEP System) for fiscal year July 1, 2008 through June 30, 2009 shall be Five Hundred Fifty Four Dollars and no cents (\$554.00) plus Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) per Single Family Residence.

The sewer service charge for residential customers served by a Septic Tank Effluent Pumping System (STEP System) for fiscal year July 1, 2009 through June 30, 2010 shall be Five Hundred Seventy Four Dollars and no cents (\$574.00) plus Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) per Single Family Residence.

Section 2.
Article IX, Section 900 (04) (A), (B), and (C) are hereby amended in their entirety to read as follows:

(04) Non-Residential Customers Sewer Service Charge.
(A) The rates for customers in the non-residential category for fiscal year July 1, 2005 through June 30, 2006 shall be computed on the basis of:

(1) A flow rate charge of \$2.36 per hundred cubic feet of metered water consumption in accordance with the formula set forth for non-residential customers. **PROVIDED** that District may make adjustments where it appears to District that water consumption is not a reasonably accurate measure of wastewater discharge.

(2) A biochemical oxygen demand rate of \$0.1904 per pound per hundred cubic feet of water consumption; and

(3) A suspended solids loading rate of \$0.1777 per pound per hundred cubic feet of water consumption.

(A) The rates for customers in the non-residential category for fiscal year July 1, 2006 through June 30, 2007 shall be computed on the basis of:

(1) A flow rate charge of \$2.449 per hundred cubic feet of metered water consumption in accordance with the formula set forth for non-residential customers. **PROVIDED** that District may make adjustments where it appears to District that water consumption is not a reasonably accurate measure of wastewater discharge.

(2) A biochemical oxygen demand rate of \$0.1945 per pound per hundred cubic feet of water consumption; and

(3) A suspended solids loading rate of \$0.2444 per pound per hundred cubic feet of water consumption.

(4) A supplemental flow rate charge \$0.4657 per hundred cubic feet of metered water consumption.

(AB) The rates for customers in the non-residential category for fiscal year July 1, 2007 through June 30, 2008 shall be computed on the basis of:

(1) A flow rate charge of \$2.635 per hundred cubic feet of metered water consumption in accordance with the formula set forth for non-residential customers. **PROVIDED** that District may make adjustments where it appears to District that water consumption is not a reasonably accurate measure of wastewater discharge.

(2) A biochemical oxygen demand rate of \$0.1945 per pound per hundred cubic feet of water consumption; and

(3) A suspended solids loading rate of \$0.2444 per pound per hundred cubic feet of water consumption.

(4) A supplemental flow rate charge \$0.4657 per hundred cubic feet of metered water consumption.

(AC) The rates for customers in the non-residential category for fiscal year July 1, 2008 through June 30, 2009 shall be computed on the basis of:

(1) A flow rate charge of \$2.821 per hundred cubic feet of metered water consumption in accordance with the formula set forth for non-residential customers. **PROVIDED** that District may make adjustments where it appears to District that water consumption is not a reasonably accurate measure of wastewater discharge.

(2) A biochemical oxygen demand rate of \$0.1945 per pound per hundred cubic feet of water consumption; and

(3) A suspended solids loading rate of \$0.2444 per pound per hundred cubic feet of water consumption.

(4) A supplemental flow rate charge \$0.4657 per hundred cubic feet of metered water consumption.

(AD) The rates for customers in the non-residential category for fiscal year July 1, 2009 through June 30, 2010 shall be computed on the basis of:

(1) A flow rate charge of \$3.007 per hundred cubic feet of metered water consumption in accordance with the formula set forth for non-residential customers. **PROVIDED** that District may make adjustments where it appears to District that water consumption is not a reasonably accurate measure of wastewater discharge.

(2) A biochemical oxygen demand rate of \$0.1945 per pound per hundred cubic feet of water consumption; and

(3) A suspended solids loading rate of \$0.2444 per pound per hundred cubic feet of water consumption.

(4) A supplemental flow rate charge \$0.4657 per hundred cubic feet of metered water consumption.

(B) Biochemical oxygen demand (BOD) and suspended solids (SS) loading are defined for the following categories of non-residential customers:

C = Sewer Service Charge for non-residential customer.

V = Metered or estimated volume of wastewater discharge

for a calendar year in hundreds of cubic feet (CCF).

F = Flow rate charge per CCF.

B = Biochemical Oxygen Demand (BOD) rate charge per CCF, as defined or measured.

S = Suspended Solids (SS) rate charge per CCF, as defined or measured.

Chemical oxygen demand (COD) may be substituted for biochemical oxygen (BOD) in the above formula when, in the opinion of the District Manager, COD is more truly representative in defining oxygen demand than BOD. For the purpose of this determination, BOD is determined to be one-half of the measured milligrams per liter COD.

STEP System Non-Residential Customer Rate.

The sewer service charge for non-residential customers served by a Septic Tank Effluent Pumping System (STEP System) for fiscal year July 1, 2005 through June 30, 2006 shall be Four Hundred Ninety Four Dollars and no cents (\$494.00) for each 220 gallons per day, average annual daily flow rate, discharged to the District's sewer system.

The sewer service charge for non-residential customers served by a Septic Tank Effluent Pumping System (STEP System) for fiscal year July 1, 2006 through June 30, 2007 shall be Five Hundred Fourteen Dollars and no cents (\$514.00) plus Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) Supplemental Charge for each 220 gallons per day, average annual daily flow rate, discharged to the District's sewer system.

The sewer service charge for non-residential customers served by a Septic Tank Effluent Pumping System (STEP System) for fiscal year July 1, 2007 through June 30, 2008 shall be Five Hundred Thirty Four Dollars and no cents (\$534.00) plus Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) Supplemental Charge for each 220 gallons per day, average annual daily flow rate, discharged to the District's sewer system.

The sewer service charge for non-residential customers served by a Septic Tank Effluent Pumping System (STEP System) for fiscal year July 1, 2008 through June 30, 2009 shall be Five Hundred Fifty Four Dollars and no cents (\$554.00) plus Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) Supplemental Charge for each 220 gallons per day, average annual daily flow rate, discharged to the District's sewer system.

The sewer service charge for non-residential customers served by a Septic Tank Effluent Pumping System (STEP System) for fiscal year July 1, 2009 through June 30, 2010 shall be Five Hundred Seventy Four Dollars and no cents (\$574.00) plus Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) Supplemental Charge for each 220 gallons per day, average annual daily flow rate, discharged to the District's sewer system.

Section 3.

In accordance with the California Environmental Quality Act ("CEQA") Public Resources Code Sec. 2100 et seq., and the regulations promulgated pursuant to CEQA, the District Board finds that this Regulation establishes rates and/or charges for the purpose of meeting operating expenses of the District, meeting financial reserves needs and requirements of the District, and obtaining funds for capital projects which are necessary to maintain services within existing service areas in the District.

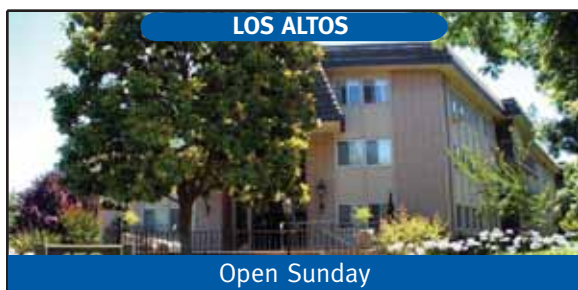
