

Desperation, determination

Menlo Park film shows how thousands of Iranian Shiites face fear and death to visit shrine in Iraq

Since the fall of Saddam Hussein, thousands of Shiite Muslims have descended upon the border town of Mehran, Iran, on a daily basis. They are on their way to the holy city of Karbala, Iraq, where there is a shrine of martyred Imam Hussein, grandson of Mohammed.

The events in Mehran are the focus of a 2005 documentary, "Pilgrimage," that Marjaneh Moghimi co-produced with the director Bahman Giarostami. "Pilgrimage" will be shown on Oct. 28 at Stanford University as part of a documentary film festival.

Ms. Moghimi is the founder and director of Butimar Productions in Menlo Park, a nonprofit that backed the film. "Butimar's mission is to promote Iranian art and culture," she says. And "Pilgrimage" shows a slice of that cultural life.

The filmmakers decided to focus on Mehran due to the combination of human emotion and determination they saw there, says Ms. Moghimi in an interview. Rather than filming the shrine itself, they decided to show how people reacted at the border between Iran and Iraq.

"Karbala in Iraq is very

dangerous because the shrine is a symbol. There are body searches; cell phones are not allowed," she says. And Karbala is only 50 miles south of Baghdad.

But the people are determined to go. The shrine draws not only Iranian Shiites, but religious people from neighboring countries, as well as Iraqis living in Iran.

"At the shrine, people become very emotional," says Ms. Moghimi. "They ask favors like 'please save my son from cancer' and they cry. They chant their needs and wants. It's an intimate

moment, a release."

"Pilgrimage" shows the optimism of those who made it into the backs of Karbala-bound trucks, packed in and covered with tarps.

But there is also the desperation of others who aren't allowed out of Iran, and those who don't have papers to re-enter the country. The film shows the chaos of crowds of people pleading with overworked customs officials.

"The head of the judicial committee explains how this was a catch-22 for the government. They looked the other way," says Ms. Moghimi. But those entering without papers were fined.

Shiites feel it is a privilege to go, and they are willing to risk their lives to do so, believing they will become martyrs if they die. Several hundred people have died en route.

Some of the bodies made it back to the morgue at Mehran, and the film shows an interview with the doctor there. In a poignant moment, he displays personal belongings that the morgue holds for family members to pick up.

People's reactions at film screenings have varied. Iranians in the U.S. feel filmmakers should concentrate on the reformist and diverse aspects of Iran. Americans typically have questions about the logistics of the film.

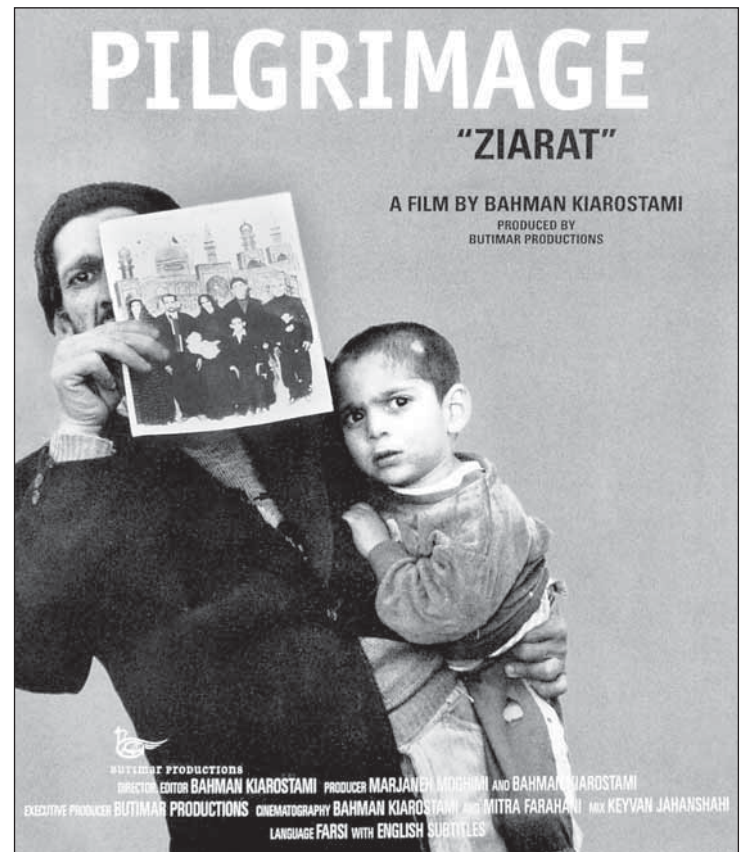
