## Vintage cigarette ad exhibit focuses on industry manipulation

The kindly looking doctor in a white lab coat holds up a package of Lucky Strike cigarettes, gazing at them fondly.

"20,679 Physicians say 'Luckies are less irritating.' Your Throat Protection against irritation, against cough," the colorful ad proclaims.

Dr. Robert Jackler, professor and chair of otolaryngology at Stanford, was struck by the ad's audacious misuse of the physician's iconic image of authority. He purchased the 1940s-era image at a Marin County flea market several years ago, never realizing it would spawn an exhibit.

Now, Dr. Jackler and his wife, artist Laurie Jackler, have amassed hundreds of the glossy images, which they are sharing with the public at an exhibition at Stanford's Lane Medical Library through May.

Wise, beneficent physicians, scientists, celebrities, sports stars, Santa Claus and even babies were used by cigarette companies in a deadly, manipulative campaign to lure new young smokers from

1920 to 1954.

The exhibit sheds light on tobacco company tactics by showing how orchestrated campaigns have worked over time. The Jacklers and Robert Proctor, a Stanford professor of history and science, are writing a book featuring many of the vintage ads.

The exhibition has poignancy for Dr. Jackler, whose mother, a long-term smoker, was diagnosed with lung cancer shortly after the couple began their collection six months ago, he said.

The exhibit's title, "Not a cough in a carload," comes from an Old Gold cigarette slogan, just one of many that billed cigarettes as being soothing and healthful.

Although the couple initially focused on ads featuring doctors, the exhibit also features celebrities, from W.C. Fields ("Even a sword swallower needs the throat-ease of Old Gold") to Lucille Ball. Many of them died from lung cancer, he said.

The ads themselves are visually stunning, Ms. Jackler said. To

bring that same vibrancy to the vintage collection, she digitally restored the aging, yellowed ads for the exhibit.

One of her favorites is of Audrey Hepburn wearing a hat brimmed with cigarettes. Another stunner, a Lucky Strike ad from 1932, depicts a man blowing smoke rings — one of which becomes a diamond engagement ring slip-



ping onto the finger of a woman's outstretched hand. The caption reads: "Forever and ever."

Dr. Jackler called the campaigns "an era of complete hucksterism."

As the public began to associate oral and lung cancers with smoking, tobacco companies embarked on campaigns that shifted with the prevailing social

and political winds of the times. The golden age of cigarette ads ended in 1954, when the Federal Trade Commission clamped down on tobacco companies making health claims.

Tobacco was a known cause of oral cancer as early as the 18th century, but the link to lung cancer wasn't accepted until the early 1940s and '50s, Dr. Jackler said. When physician Isaac Adler made the connection in 1912, he was forced to apologize. At the time, lung cancer disease was considered rare.

But by the 1920s, the public was beginning to take a closer look, forcing tobacco companies to shift strategies. People were calling cigarettes "cancer nails."

The iconic image of the doctor in a white lab coat appeared in ads for three decades, often backed by pseudoscience. The industry sponsored "research institutes," and handed out cartons of cigarettes at medical conventions, Dr. Jackler said.

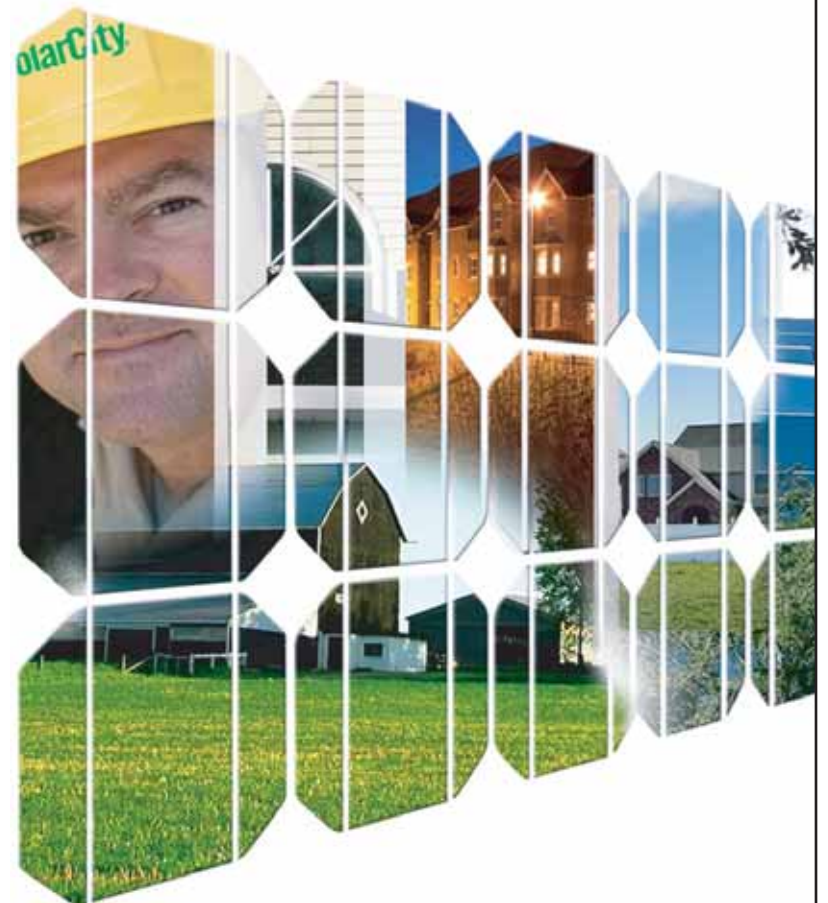

At a booth near the door, doctors would be given a pack of Camels.

"The doctor would put the pack in his shirt pocket, and when he left, another person would ask, 'What cigarette do you smoke, Doctor?' and the doctor would pull out the pack of Camels. That's how they could claim, 'The brand named most by doctors,' " he said.

Often, ads contained vignettes: the doctor offering soothing assurances; making a house call to an elderly grandmother; in the lab creating antibiotics — images designed to associate the product with compassion and good health.

Over time, cigarettes were claimed to aid everything from weight loss to digestion.

The idea wasn't so far-fetched. In the 19th century, smoking was believed to help lower the risk of deadly diseases such as diphtheria and typhus.

During the London plague of 1665, children were instructed to smoke in the classroom as a way to avoid getting the disease according to Robert Proctor, who has studied the history of the tobacco industry for 20 years and helped put together the exhibition.

The menthol cigarette caused

a huge jump in sales. Kool put forth a campaign calling their brand "a breath of fresh air."

The makers of Kools targeted African Americans in the 1950s as part of a lifestyle that included cool jazz, Dr. Jackler said. The success of that campaign is still apparent today — 68 percent of African American smokers use menthol cigarettes, he added.

"*Inhale to your heart's content,*" an ad intoned.

Women became early targets of tobacco companies when cigarettes became symbols of emancipation. Trading on the women's suffrage movement, the American Tobacco Company advertised cigarettes to women as "torches of freedom." And in a 1912 ad, a woman proclaimed, "I wish I were a man. (So I could smoke.)"

The campaign was successful over time. Only 5 percent of American women smoked in 1923, but that number peaked at 33 percent in 1965, Mr. Proctor said.

"In the 1950s, lung cancer was a rare disease. In 2000, it was killing nearly 70,000 people per year. Lung cancer surpassed breast cancer as the leading cause of cancer death among women in 1987," he said.

Filters helped boost cigarette sales dramatically, according to Mr. Proctor. In 1950, only 2 percent of smokers smoked a filter cigarette. In 2005, that number was 99 percent, he said. But the most deadly industrial setting of the 1960s was the filter factory. At least one brand of filter cigarettes, the Kent micronite filter, was made of asbestos.

"Smokers inhaled millions of deadly fibers per year and were never told of the hazards," he said.

Today, 5.7 trillion cigarettes are smoked every year, and 13- to 21-year-olds are still major targets of marketing campaigns, he said. The exploitation has merely taken a different form.

Although some medical schools won't take tobacco company money for research, others — including Stanford, which accepted \$2.6 million in Philip Morris support — still do, Mr. Proctor said.

## Atherton unveils Earth Action Week

The town of Atherton is going green in a big way, and we're not just talking about the trees that surround the opulent homes. The town has decided that one Earth Day just isn't enough.

This year, the town's Environmental Programs Committee is sponsoring Earth Action Week, seven days of environmental events and activities to get residents thinking green, capped by an all-day Earth Day expo on April 21, followed by a reception and dance.

The week starts with three nights of do-it-yourself environmentalism. On Sunday, April 15, residents are asked to calculate their household's carbon emissions using Web sites such as Acterra.org or TerraPass.org.

On Monday, Athertonians can help change the world by changing their light bulbs

from standard incandescents to compact fluorescent lamps, which use one third of the energy. Information is available at 18seconds.org.

Tuesday, April 17, is the day for residents to sign up for PG&E's Climate Smart program at PGE.com to reduce the impact of household carbon emissions.

On Wednesday, April 18, a double-feature of environmental documentaries plays at the Pavilion at Holbrook-Palmer Park, 150 Watkins Ave. "An Inconvenient Truth" shows at 7 p.m. and "Who Killed the Electric Car" shows at 9 p.m. Tickets are \$5 at the door, and free popcorn and snacks will be served. The double feature plays again on Friday, April 20, at the same times.

On Thursday, April 19, residents are invited to create an action plan for solar energy. A round table discussion includes information on global warming

from climatologist Julio Magalhaes; Acterra representatives discussing the Green@home program's simple steps to reduce household carbon emissions; and folks from Solar City will reveal how to make household photovoltaic systems a cash-positive proposition from the get-go. The free event will be held in the Pavilion from 7 to 9 p.m.

Earth Day, Saturday, April 21, has a day-long Environmental Expo, capped by an evening reception and dance. From 10 a.m. to 4 p.m. at Holbrook-Palmer Park, exhibits and children's activities will highlight environmental products and services. Tesla Motors will feature rides in its high-performance electric sports cars and a wild animal show is set for 1 p.m. Wine-tasting, tree planting and driving electric scooters are also on tap.

Exhibitors include Hidden Villa, the Wildlife Conservation

Network, PG&E, Sustainable San Mateo County and Sustainable Spaces. Organic snacks will be available to purchase.

An electronic waste recycling event will go on at the same time. Old computers, televisions, photocopiers, DVD players, cameras, batteries, compact fluorescent light bulbs, fax machines and other e-waste will be collected. Pharmaceutical waste, such as expired medications, will also be collected.

On Saturday from 7 to 11 p.m., the "Eco-Lifestyle Reception and Dance," featuring music by the Pork Bellies Band, takes over

the Pavilion. Organic wine will be flowing, and there will be an eco-fashion show. Tickets are \$35 if purchased by April 18, \$50 thereafter.

Entries from the children's art contest will be displayed in the Pavilion. Kids in kindergarten through grade 8 are invited to submit entries by April 16 to the Atherton Building Dept., 93 Station Lane in Atherton. Judging will be supervised by Art in Action.

## PETER TRINKAUS



Peter Trinkaus M.D. died March 29, 2007 after a long battle with cancer. His life was dedicated to the care of children and to the care of his family. Peter was born in 1953 in Bronxville NY to Sarah and Charles Trinkaus. Charles was a Professor of History at Sarah Lawrence College and Sarah was a teacher of piano. Peter

attended high school at the Horace Mann School in New York and Pioneer High School in Ann Arbor when Charles became a Professor of History at University of Michigan. He graduated from Amherst College with a major in Neuroscience. He earned his M.D. at University of Michigan, and then came to Stanford University for his internship and residency in Pediatrics. He met his wife, Martha during his year as Chief Resident when she was on her pediatrics clinical rotation.

Peter was a Clinical Instructor in Pediatrics in the Pediatric ICU at Santa Clara Valley Medical Center, then an Assistant Professor of Pediatrics at Temple University and Director of the Pediatric ICU at Albert Einstein Medical Center in Philadelphia, while Martha completed her residency and fellowship in Neurology. Upon their return to California, Peter joined Kaiser Santa Clara as Director of the Pediatric ICU. In 1998, the family moved to New York and Peter served as an Assistant Professor of Pediatrics at Columbia University and as a Pediatric Intensivist at the Babies and Children's Hospital of New

York. In 2004, Peter joined Packard Hospital's ICU staff and served as a Clinical Associate Professor of Pediatrics at Stanford University.

Peter was devoted to his family. His children- Emily 18, Samuel 13 and Madeline 10, were the center of his world and the source of his greatest joy. He was an absolutely committed parent, helping with homework, art projects, sports, Brownie Meetings, and even hair braiding. He also derived joy from the home he created for his family. He was an excellent cook, athlete, naturalist, and gardener. He was a lover of classical music and literature.

Peter's compassion, keen intelligence and absolute dedication to his patients were evident throughout his career. He approached each patient with both his mind and heart engaged.

Peter is survived by his mother, Sarah, of Ann Arbor, Michigan; his wife Martha Morrell MD; his children Emily, Samuel and Madeline Trinkaus; Marylyn and James Morrell, his mother and father in law; and David Morrell and Kirsten Gruesz, his brother and sister-in-law.

Peter's absence is a great loss to his family, his friends all over the world, and to the children who will not benefit from his gifts as a physician. A memorial service was held at the Valley Presbyterian Church in Portola Valley on Saturday, April 7 at 3:00.
