My daughter, who is a junior in college in San Diego and just turned 21, sounded totally panicked and ready to burst into tears when she called.

"Mom," she said, and then talked so fast I couldn't understand her. "Slow down," I said. Had she been in an accident? Hurt? Sick? What?

At last she got through to me. "I dropped my phone!" she said.

"The screen broke! I can't get text messages!"

I stopped worrying, but obviously she had not. This was a major crisis. She just could not function. In fact, as soon as she had finished work for the day, Caitlin had hitched a ride with a friend to the mall, and was at that moment in the cell phone store trying to get a new phone that would receive text messages.

The call to me was because they wouldn't let her sign a new contract without my permission.

Caitlin's cell phone still functioned as a phone. She still had her computers (laptop and desktop) for e-mail and instant messages. But obviously, life could not go on without text messages.

We worked through the crisis, although it took two trips to the cell phone store by my husband, one with me along, and at least one more by Caitlin before she was calmed down with a new phone in hand.

My children do not communicate in the same way I do. They expect to instantly be able to reach anyone at any time. I am doing my best to catch on, but I am afraid I will never be able to type into my phone faster than one word per five minutes.
