Menlo Park culinary wiz has flair for creating community while serving up 'feasts of flavor'

When the Almanac put out the call in March for nominations of local "kitchen gods and goddesses" to feature in a series of "Home Chef" articles, the responses were plentiful.

So many choices — how could we possibly decide? Easy. Not only was Kellie Barrow of Menlo Park the only person to receive multiple nominations, she was crowned with laurel leaves — figuratively speaking, anyway — by friends, colleagues and neighbors who have been happy beneficiaries of her culinary talents.

And because one of the criteria for choosing a home chef to feature in our series is that the culinary wiz is also someone who enjoys sharing the pleasures of the table with friends, Kellie was a natural to feature in the series' premiere article. Dubbed by neighbors as "the neighborhood cruise director," she cooks for friends often and generously.

"Kellie has friends over for dinner at the drop of the hat," says Karen Machtinger, the Barrows' next-door neighbor and longtime friend.

And it's often not your typical dinner. Friday night margarita parties, a mashed potato bar (guests top their potatoes with choices from an array of herbs, vegetables and condiments), a paella party, a "white trash" dinner with White Castle hamburgers and french fries, crab-cracking dinners (each guest brings a crab), and cooking parties where all hands are at work in the kitchen — these have become fond memories for friends who recommended Kellie for a Home Chef feature.

The "do-it-yourself" cooking party in late March kept her friends and kids engaged at separate work stations in

the kitchen, where she had placed recipes and set up ingredients. They prepared, then feasted on, pork medallions, homemade pasta with a fresh tomato cream sauce, green beans and chocolate torte. "It was so much fun," Kellie says.

"I think nurturing people with food goes back to the basic instinct of caring," she explains. "When celebrating a union of two people or (noting) the death of a loved one, food helps heal and invite people to celebrate life."

Kellie's Kitchen

Kellie and Jim Barrow live with their two sons — Scott, 17, and Brian, 15 — in the Allied Arts neighborhood. When guests enter the spacious kitchen of the Barrows' house, the first thing they're likely to notice is a large, wrought-iron

sign above the kitchen-sink window: Kellie's Kitchen.

A skylight above a huge wood-top island adds to the warm and welcoming ambience of the kitchen, which Kellie moves about, barefoot, with authority and unmistakable cheer the day before a recent party. She was preparing food for about 25 guests and family members, and already had the "mac and cheese" she made over the weekend in the freezer, and ingredients such as pesto and Hawaiian barbecue marinade she made earlier at the ready.

"I get everything ready ahead of time because (once friends arrive), I like to party," she says.

With the party set for Friday evening, she's in the kitchen Thursday afternoon trimming and marinating ribs — 24 pounds of them.

She's also preparing one of her friends' favorite appetizers: a pesto torte that must

chill in the fridge for hours, and is therefore a good choice to prepare the day before. She uses a pink, countertop electric mixer to blend cream cheese and butter to layer with her homemade pesto.

When the top comes off the pesto container, the intense aroma is enough to make her observer swoon. She understands. "Cooking wakes the senses," she declares.

Serving up memories

Raised in San Jose, Kellie points to family as key influences for her love of cooking and sharing meals with others. She talks about her father's and paternal grandmother's memorable meals, and notes: "Our kitchen (when I was) growing up was always full of great aromas and conversations."

Her maternal grandparents, who lived in Burlingame, opened their home on holidays and Sundays, hosting their seven adult children, their spouses and their grandkids for casual meals. "It was so comfortable going there, and they loved having people around," Kellie recalls.

Her grandmother, she says, "loved antiques, but never seemed bothered about worrying that one of the grandchildren would break anything. So I think that is why I

am so calm about my house."

She was impressed early on by her grandfather's words, "Life is just a bunch of memories." And now, she says, "I feel like I would rather create the memories than have an untouched, pristine house."

Sharing good food made with care and consideration for others, Kellie emphasizes, nurtures not only the body but friendships and a sense of community as well. Judging by the enthusiasm and affection her friends show toward her, it's a sound philosophy.

Kellie's fans range from neighbors to work colleagues — she's a part-time teacher's aide at Oak Knoll School — to members of her bunco (a dice game) club. The 12-member club meets monthly, each month at a member's home on a rotating schedule.

When the "Bunco Babes" heard that Kellie would be featured in an Almanac article, they got together to write down their impressions. When it's Kellie's turn to host the bunco club, they write, "we always know that (the) night will be a feast of flavors."

She's treated them to theme-based meals, including a Mediterranean menu that included "a special paella to die for," they note. "And it's not just about the food; it's about the senses."

Chalupa

With Cinco de Mayo coming up, Kellie's been thinking about a chalupa recipe she made last summer for a World Cup soccer party. "People went for seconds," she says.

1 lb., pinto beans
3 lb. pork roast
7 cups of water
1/2 cup, chopped onion
2 cloves, minced garlic
1 Tbsp. salt
2 Tbsp. chili powder
2 Tbsp. cumin
1 tsp. dried oregano
1 4-oz. can, chopped green chilis
1 2-oz. jar, pimentos

In a large, oven-safe pot, place roast, water, onion, garlic, seasonings, chilies, and pimentos. Cover and cook for 5 hours at 350 degrees.

Remove roast from pot and break up with a fork. The meat should fall apart easily. Put meat back into the pot. You can now refrigerate it for later or keep it out until ready to serve.

When ready to serve, heat until boiling.

Serve in bowls. Guests can top with fixings — for example, corn chips, shredded cheddar cheese, avocado, sour cream, green onion, diced tomato, shredded lettuce, chopped fresh yellow onion, hot sauce.

Serves 10-12.

Pesto torte

This appetizer is a favorite of Kellie's friends, and it can be made the day before the party.

8 oz. cream cheese, room temperature
8 oz. butter, room temperature
Fresh pesto, made with 1 bunch of basil

Spread wet cheesecloth or a wet, lint-free kitchen cloth on the bottom and sides of a bowl about the size of a cereal bowl, or another vessel of similar capacity. The vessel will serve as a mold for the torte. The cloth should overhang the bowl.

Mix the butter and cream cheese together, then spread and pat down a layer of it on the bottom of the lined bowl. Next, spread a layer of pesto. Continue alternating the cream cheese mix and the pesto, with a layer of the cream cheese mix topping the torte. Press down to tightly pack.

Cover with the cloth that's overhanging the bowl and refrigerate for at least five hours. Take out about 30 minutes before serving, uncover the top, invert into a plate and carefully lift the bowl, then the cloth, from the torte. Serve with crackers or freshly baked bread.

Varner brothers' locally produced chardonnays win high marks

Based in a small office in downtown Menlo Park, Varner has produced two 2004 wines that were recently awarded 95-point scores by wine critic Robert Parker.

"This vintage was the best to date, so I wasn't surprised," recalls Jim Varner.

Twin brothers Bob and Jim Varner planted their first vineyard in 1980 in Portola Valley, and it soon became a consuming passion. They harvested their first grapes in 1984 and sold them to other wineries.

It wasn't until 1996 that they started to produce wine under their own label — Varner.

Partners in wine

The brothers have partnered with the owners of the Portola vineyard, Kirk Neely and Holly Mires. "You need a special partnership with everyone involved," says Jim.

"What makes the relationship work is a shared goal of making the best wines in the most natural way possible."

The Varner brothers divide the responsibilities of the winery. Employing his degree in genetics from the University of California, Davis, Bob manages both the vineyard and winemaking. He makes the wine in a small building on the vineyard property.

Jim has a degree in enology (also UC Davis) and focuses on sales

and marketing.

How did the Varners come to make wine on the Peninsula? "We chose this location because the area surrounding Menlo Park is conducive to the type of wine we wanted to make," Jim explains. "Portola Valley has a cool, French-like climate."

In addition, the brothers consider Menlo Park to be a great location for the wine trade. "This area is the center of wine," Jim notes.

Vineyard-designated wines

The Varner wines come from specific blocks of the vineyard and highlight the flavors of each location's microclimate and soil. They are named after simple descriptions of the land.

The Hidden Block Pinot Noir comes from a site that used to be hidden from the road. Amphitheater Block Chardonnay is a wine that comes from a section of vineyard that looks like amphitheater.

In addition, they have a second label, Foxglove Chardonnay.

The Home Vineyard Chardonnay and the Neely Chardonnay both scored 95 points in the December edition of the Wine Advocate, the publication by Robert Parker. "An impressive producer, especially of Chardonnay... pricing remains reasonable in view of the quality," writes Mr. Parker.

Regarding management of the vineyard, Jim advises, "Don't compromise quality for quantity."

"After the vines have been established for five years the irrigation is turned off. It's dry-farmed," he

says.

No insecticides, no pesticides, and no fertilizers are used so that the native populations are not destroyed. By maintaining native habitat, the land is home to bobcats, hawks, coyotes, and rabbits.

"All those animals indicate it's healthy," Bob notes.

Winemaking philosophy

The Varners employ traditional, natural techniques. First, the grapes are hand-picked and hand-sorted. Then they crush and destem the grapes and ferment with native yeasts. (The chardonnay is barrel-fermented.)

When fermentation is complete, the wine is transferred to French oak barrels. After eight to 11 months, the wine is bottled without fining or filtration.

"Oak adds weight and structure and a nice counterpoint to the fruit," Bob explains.

By permit, the winery is not

After a brief period stretched out on the sofa in the adjacent living room, Kellie springs back to action to put the finishing touches on the plates, including a scattering of fresh parsley from the box garden outside her kitchen window.

An avid gardener, Kellie grows herbs, tomatoes, squash and other edible plants that supplement the bounty she brings home from farmers' markets.

As with most of her parties, the food is presented buffet-style, and
