## Raising funds for, awareness of, Cambodian children

Sometimes an omen is as slight as a smile that seems to speak beyond its expression. A recent Saturday morning sign was simple enough and came in the form of a woman, the first customer to visit the lemonade stand we had set up on the corner of Portola and Alpine roads to benefit Cambodian children we had met during our summer vacation.

"I've been to Cambodia," she said, looking at the poster our kids had made, which had pictures of the Cambodian children and information on the school our lemonade stand would benefit. "I'll be back," she said. "I want to get involved." This began our day, which would end on an equally high note.

Several families had gathered to sell lemonade, Gatorade and other assorted treats to benefit the children we had met on our summer trip to Cambodia. Our family along with the Changs, Myers and Flowers fami-

lies — all from Portola Valley — were lucky to have met these beautiful children, many orphans, all from impoverished circumstances.

The faces of the children came home with us, simultaneously haunting and inspiring us. These children, born of intense poverty in the wake of devastation caused by the Khmer Rouge genocide, bear the mark of their scarcity, yet incredibly reflect immense anticipation of change.

This dual expression of desolation and hope, a powerful juxtaposition, has now made an indelible mark on our souls. We were fortunate to meet Ponheary Ly, a Cambodian teacher who survived the genocide to create a foundation that built the rural school we visited.

This school faces many challenges beyond educating the children. The distance to the school is several miles for some, and many children don't go to school. The basic need of food for their families keep many of the children begging at the temples. Our chil-

dren were affected by what they saw; the lemonade stand was their idea.

While raising money for the foundation was our goal, our stand was more about giving our kids a chance to make a difference by simply telling the story of the children they met, children who now are part of their own story. The outpouring of support from the community and passers-by for our stand was inspiring.

Not only did people buy lemonade and make donations. They shared their own stories and we learned of other tremendous efforts on behalf of others in need.

The highlight of the day came at the end as we were packing up. One of our mutual friends, Tina Molumphy, jogged by and told us that her son Kevin, a 7-year-old, would have come but he had set up his own lemonade stand in front of their house so he, too, could raise money to "help the poor people."

It worked. Our kids raised about \$540 on the corner that morning, plus \$48 that came from Kevin.

We hope this is just a start. We will do more, and have talked about starting an endowment or other income-producing fund to benefit the children. 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## Miles takes the wet and wild rapids

River rafting: beautiful scenery, getting in touch with nature, but doing this while maneuvering 30 waterfalls that can potentially take the lives of those who are not paying attention.

Of course, I may be exaggerating a little since people ages 4 to 90 do this somewhat extreme sport, but even so, it can be dangerous. I recently went river rafting on the American River near Sacramento as part of a class trip, and I have never been so exhilarated during school time.

Granted, we did have to get up at 3:30 a.m. to get there in time, but it was worth it. The first day we rafted the Middle Fork, the most intense part of the American River. It has Class 4 rapids, including the infamous Tunnel Chute, which drops around 300 feet, and other rapids such as Pinball and Parallel Parking.

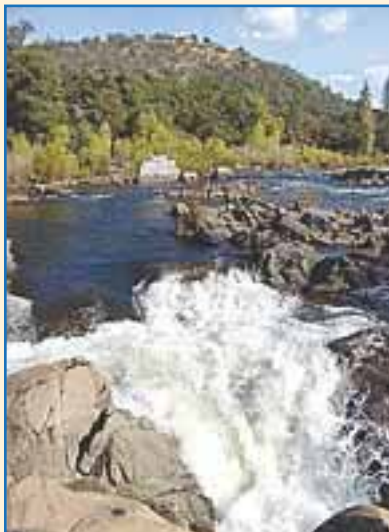
Tunnel Chute is the most intense. We went through a narrow carved-out area of the river with huge waves, then dropped, ending in a hand-carved tunnel built almost 100 years ago.

Luckily, our guide was very experienced, and had many good tips. He also pointed out the scenery as we rafted.

We saw a mountain called the Green Lantern, named this because of the green dragonflies that glow inside of it at night.

Compared to a few other guides, ours was much more experienced, which came in handy when we dropped over the 8-foot waterfall. Another guide had no idea what to do.

Nevertheless, with a few exceptions, all the guides knew which lines to raft and got every student out safely. There were some who got a few gashes from a supposed "swimmers" rapid

that contained large jutting rocks.

Despite the 100-degree weather, the rapid-water was freezing, but it provided relief from the "near-Saharan" temperatures.

The lunch was a gourmet deli bar, something you'd never expect to eat in a spot surrounded by poison oak, with the potential of seeing mountain lions and rattlesnakes.

Everyone made it through the first day, which was also the more intense of the trip. The second day had smaller rapids, but just as dangerous. Troublemaker, a well-known rapid, almost flipped the tourist boat behind us, which made our guide nervous, so he prepared to rescue them.

Fortunately, lady luck was on their side. We did all of this while floating through the original Gold Country, seeing a land rich with history; but the views paled in comparison to the whitewater.

Overall it was a fantastic trip. If you want to try the whitewater, just remember to tie your pants tight, because one of the rapids is famous for stripping people down to their, um, core.

## Menlo dominates in fifth Valparaiso Bowl

The Menlo Knights offense featuring a trio of backs overpowered the Sacred Heart Gators, as Menlo cruised to a 38-12 victory in the Fifth Annual Valparaiso Bowl on Sept. 8 at Woodside High School.

In the fifth contest between the two Atherton neighbors on Valparaiso Avenue, Menlo jumped out to an early lead, scoring five times in the first half, while shutting out Sacred Heart Prep and holding its offense to under 50 yards.

Ryan O'Holleran led Menlo with 140 yards rushing and one touchdown on 11 carries. Jerry Rice Jr. had 12 carries for 91 yards and two touchdowns while catching three passes for 45 yards.

Travis Boyce threw for 267 yards and one touchdown pass

to R.J. Carver, while adding a third option to Menlo's rushing attack: gaining 92 yards and a touchdown on the ground. Carver led all receivers with seven catches for 160 yards.

"We were able to run the ball effectively and had some long passing plays," said Rice Jr.

However, despite trailing immensely at the end of the first half, Sacred Heart Prep remained active in the game and managed to score twice in the second half. Matt Bocci scored on a six-yard run, and Ryan Sakowski connected with Kevin Lamb for a 54-yard passing touchdown. Sakowski finished with 89 yards passing, one touchdown and two interceptions.

"Defensively, we executed our game plan really well," said

Menlo head coach Mark Newton. "We were trying to force the run outside, and then have our corners and our safeties come up and make plays. We did a really good job of doing that."

The Knights held Sacred Heart to 184 total yards of offense, with Gavin Williams and Adrian Rosenkranz each catching interceptions. Menlo also managed to stop Sacred Heart on both of their two-point conversion attempts.

Rosenkranz also made all five of his extra point attempts, as well as a 37-yard field goal.

The non-league game, which drew more than 2,000 people, marked the fifth time the two schools have met, with Menlo defeating Sacred Heart Prep' young football program four times. ■
