A Taste OF TERROIR

Anyone who thinks of winemakers and wine aficionados as pretentiously, overbearingly serious really should meet Ken Wornick.

A winemaker and proprietor of a company that manages small vineyards from Woodside and Atherton to Saratoga, Mr. Wornick is as quick with a grin and a laugh as he is with a detailed response to any question you might have about the art of making wine. A wine snob, he's not.

In fact, the motto that he and his wife, Cynthia, came up with for their La Honda Winery label sums it up well: *Lavoriamo seriamente, ma non ci prendiamo sul serio* — We take our wine seriously, but not ourselves.

Although Ken's been making wine professionally for more than 10 years, the Wornicks recently opened a new winemaking facility that's open to the public by appointment or during wine-tasting events. Located, surprisingly, in the Fair Oaks neighborhood of Redwood City, it's a restored warehouse certain to catch the attention of anyone driving by, with its striking terracotta-tone exterior, stone accents and name stamped high on the facade: La Honda Winery.

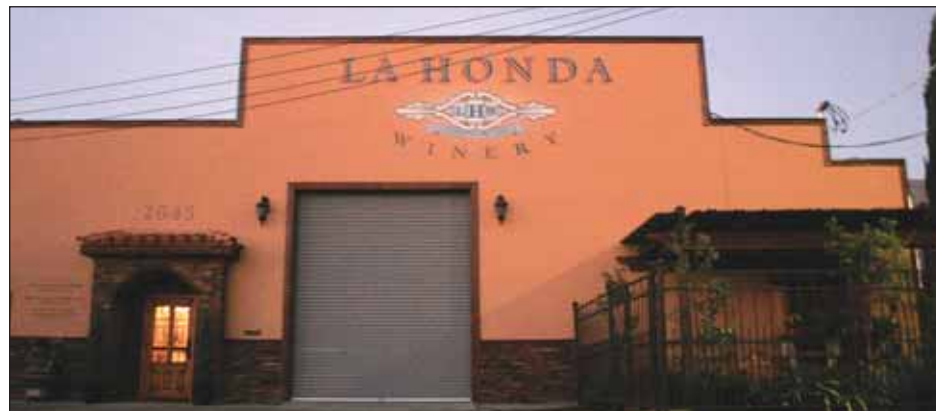
While the outside is eye-catching, the inside is a stunning mix of Wine Country style, Italianate masonry and aesthetic flourishes that reflect the tastes, talents and personalities of the Wornicks and their business partners, Don and Julie Modica.

But what about the wine?

From our backyard

their mission to familiarize themselves with wines from their own backyard. And though for most, that means wines of the Santa Cruz Mountain appellation, the wines produced by La Honda Winery add a new dimension to the quest to taste the fruit of the local terroir.

That's because much of the fruit that makes it into the bottles of La Honda's pinot noir, merlot and chardonnay come from the backyard vineyards of Woodside, Portola Valley, Atherton and other Peninsula residents who hire Mr. Wornick to plan and plant their vineyards, harvest their grapes and make their wines.

Mr. Wornick's 10-year-old company, Post & Trellis, manages about 22 such vineyards, of one-half acre to three acres in size.

Clients can either pay to have all the work done from start to finish — from managing the vineyard to corking up the bottles for their own consumption, complete with their own labels; or they can have Post & Trellis do the work and keep most of the grapes, with a specified amount returned to the client for free in the form of wine.

In addition to using clients' grapes for La Honda wines, the Wornicks also own a vineyard off Highway 84, above the small town of La Honda, where they grow cabernet sauvignon and sangiovese grapes. "It was planted as a Super Tuscan vineyard, meaning two-thirds cabernet and one-third sangiovese," Mr. Wornick explains. "The combination makes a wine quite distinct from typical over-blown alcoholic blends."

And to supplement the local fruit, Mr. Wornick also buys a limited amount of grapes from other California regions, including Napa Valley, Lodi and Chalona.

Digging the dirt

Although he's long been fascinated by winemaking, Mr. Wornick began his working career as a geologist, a fact he doesn't consider incongruous with his current endeavors. "I've always had an interest in dirt," he says. He also always wanted a job that allowed him to be outdoors a lot.

But even after earning an MBA, his interest in wine never waned. "I read, I researched, I debated" about the best winemaking practices, and eventually took almost every viticulture and winemaking extension class offered through the University of California, Davis, which has one of the best oenology departments in the country.

He made his first bottle of wine, though, years before, when he and Cynthia were living in McAllen, Texas, where there was "nothing to do all day but watch the dust blow down the streets," he recalls.

"I was by this point at least five years into reading everything on the subject of wine that I could get my hands on," he says. "So I said, 'It's time to make my first wine.'"

But where do you go for grapes in Texas? His friend, a carrot grower, helped, finding about a ton of old-vine zinfandel grapes from Mexico. So he, a pregnant Cynthia, his carrot-growing friend and his wife, also

The Mid-Peninsula League (MPL) of the San Francisco Symphony is a group of music-loving women who support the symphony. Its fundraisers include a spring garden tour and a bridge-luncheon tournament.

Tradition has it that homemade cookies are part of any symphony league event. For example, each member is asked to bake five dozen cookies to serve visitors on

the garden tours. "Our group has gained a reputation for our cookies," says member Lois Levine. "So when we were looking for a (fundraising) project, it was a no-brainer. We all agreed to do a cookie cookbook.

The result is "Signature Cookies," a 172-page cookbook filled with members' favorites, from "Ugly but Good" almond cookies to chocolate snowballs. The cookbook (\$15 plus tax) is available at Kepler's bookstore in Menlo Park.

A cookbook committee, including Betsy Furst and Judy Orttung

of Menlo Park, Elsa Heald of Los Altos, and Ms. Levine of San Carlos, tested dozens of cookie recipes submitted by League members.

Ms. Levine has published many cookbooks. She is best known for her "Elegant but Easy" cookbook, which began as a venture with friend Marion Burros back in 1953. The two women self-published 500 copies of the book, which was later accepted by a publisher and has gone on to sell a half-million copies. The "New

QUICK PEANUT BUTTER COOKIES

- 1 cup crunchy peanut butter
- 1 cup sugar
- 1 egg
- 1 teaspoon vanilla extract

Preheat oven to 350 degrees. Mix all ingredients together. Use a 1-1/4-inch scoop to drop on a cookie sheet. Bake for 15 minutes.

BRUTTI BONI

("Ugly but Good" Italian almond cookies)

- 2 cups raw almonds with skins, toasted
- 1/4 cup pine nuts, lightly toasted
- 1-1/3 cups sugar
- 2 to 3 large egg whites
- 2 tablespoons cake flour (not self-rising)
- 1/8 teaspoon salt

Preheat oven to 350 degrees. Coarsely chop almonds and pine nuts with sugar in a food processor. Lightly beat 2 egg whites and add to nuts with flour and salt. Blend until evenly moist. Dough should be slightly sticky but firm enough to hold together. If it is too dry, lightly beat remaining egg white and blend into dough 1 teaspoon at a time. Drop heaping teaspoons about 1/2 inch apart onto parchment-lined baking sheet. Gently squeeze each with your fingers to form a rough cone shape. Bake cookies in middle of oven until barely brown and moist in center, 12 to 15 minutes. Cook 5 minutes on sheet, then transfer to a rack to cool completely. Makes about 48 cookies.

Use Permit/Sprint/Nextel/300 Constitution Drive: Request for the renewal of a use permit for existing wireless telecommunications panel antennas mounted on the tower of a building and an associated equipment shelter in a fenced area adjoining the building in the M-2 (General Industrial) zoning district.

Use Permit, Architectural Control, Tentative Map, Environmental Review/1906 El Camino Real, LLC/1906 El Camino Real: Request for a use permit, architectural control, tentative parcel map, and environmental review to demolish an existing one-story, 5,750 square-foot commercial building (formerly The Acorn Restaurant) and construct a new two-story, 9,825 square-foot office building for medical/dental office use and the related site improvements at 1906 El Camino Real located in the C-4 (General Commercial applicable to El Camino Real) zoning district. pregnant, got to work.

"We had no equipment, so we crushed the fruit by hand, and fermented in a stainless steel bathtub... What a way to learn: all the wrong equipment, no lab, absolutely no supplies or tools, pregnant wives bravely wading into the tub — the story goes on and one. We had a great time."

A new home

Before finding the building at 2645 Fair Oaks Ave. that would become La Honda Winery, Mr. Wornick was making his and his clients' wines in various places, including facilities he built on clients' properties.

But when the Wornicks found the Redwood City building, which also houses Modica Landscaping, they jumped at the chance to settle into a permanent space and give the public a glimpse of their enterprise. "We realized we could have some fun with this building," Ms. Wornick explains. "It's a warm and wonderful hospitality space."

Modica Landscaping owner Don Modica became a business partner and went to work converting the spacious warehouse. The results are a feast for the eyes — walls and floors of marble, slate, sandstone and cobblestone, majestic wooden doors, a mezzanine and a kitchen for catering events.

There's an art gallery featuring local artists, managed by Julie Modica, who shows some of her own work there.

Ms. Modica and Ms. Wornick take charge of the food and other amenities at winetasting events — the last one was last weekend. Ms. Wornick, who slogged through all the government compliance chores necessary to get the winery up and running, is in charge of marketing for the business.

The winery has a 5,000-case production capacity, "but we do not plan to make more than 1,500 cases of wine," Mr. Wornick says. "The rest is for dreams."

Mr. Wornick says his winemaking techniques merge "state-of-the-art equipment with old-world winemaking." He says most of the winemaking "intervention" happens outside the winery. "We

constantly try to stretch what is possible out in the vineyards, and then resist the temptation to interfere with the fruit in the winery."

In addition to pinot noir, merlot and chardonnay, Mr. Wornick bottles sauvignon blanc, cabernet sauvignon and viognier.

"We are genuinely making great wine from vineyards in the Santa Cruz Mountains, but having the winery in downtown Redwood City is the real treat," Mr. Wornick says.

"People walk in all the time expecting a dumpy old warehouse, or that we buy fruit from some far off place. But during the harvest, the fruit from up in the hills comes straight here and is made here every day, all year long." ▴

Red Currant bistro opens at Allied Arts

Just in time for the holidays, the Red Currant bistro is open for business at the Allied Arts Guild in Menlo Park. The proprietors are Nir and Ayellet Perry, a young Israeli couple who own the Cassis Catering Company in Redwood City.

The cafe is open for breakfast and lunch 10 a.m. to 4 p.m. Monday through Saturday. Reservations are needed for groups of five or more.

The menu is more varied and sophisticated than the homestyle casseroles and gelatin salads served for so many years by members of the Palo Alto Auxiliary to the

Lucile Packard Children's Hospital. The morning choices include "shakshuka," as well as a continental breakfast. "Shakshuka" is a traditional Middle Eastern egg dish (\$12.50). It can be ordered in American, Greens, or Mediterranean style.

There are sandwiches and salads for lunch, as well as such entrees as hanger steak medallions with celery root-potato puree and caramelized onions (\$19.95) and chicken schnitzel (\$15.75).

Pastries offered at lunch include chocolate babka cake, chocolate-orange marzipan cake, and apple crumble cake. Chocolate or cara-

mel pot de creme, espresso tiramisu and lemon tart with amaretto crunch are all house-made.

The restaurant space at Allied Arts has been vacant since the end of February. That's when the Palo Alto Auxiliary, whose volunteer members ran the restaurant for 75 years, closed because the Guild's owner, the Woodside-Atherton Auxiliary, did not renew the lease.

In keeping with the terms of the auxiliary's use permit for the complex, the Red Currant won't be serving alcohol.

Elegant but Easy" is still in print.

Today Ms. Burros is a best-selling cookbook author and New York Times food columnist.

The four women on the cookie committee, who all like to bake, met every Thursday at Ms. Furst's home. "We spent many hours around my kitchen table," Ms. Furst says. Each recipe was tested.

In September the cookbook's 38 contributors were invited to Ms. Furst's home to celebrate the book's completion. Each brought a dozen of their specialty cookies so they could compare favorites.

The cookbook is divided into segments: bar cookies, biscotti, drop cookies, rolled cookies, shaped cookies, slice and bake cookies, and tarts and no-bake cookies.

There is a section on cookie-baking tips with discussions of butter versus shortening, what

kind of flour to use, how to add dry ingredients, and the advantages of using parchment paper and cookie scoops. Good cooks all, committee members say they learned a lot about baking in working on the book.

Some final "cookie thoughts" in the book's introduction quote the late James Beard: "I am still convinced that a good, simple homemade cookie is preferable to all the store-bought cookies one can find."

Another quote came from Robert Fulgham: "Think what a better world it would be, if we all, the whole world had cookies and milk about three o'clock every afternoon, and then lay down on our blankets for a nap."

"Cookie thoughts" concludes: "For those of you who are watching your waistlines, let us assure you that raw cookie dough has no calories, nor do broken cookies. So bake and enjoy our Signature Cookies." ■

POST adds acres to coastal open space

The Peninsula Open Space Trust (POST) announced Nov. 27 the purchase of 204 acres of hillside land near El Granada. The property is surrounded by the 4,262-acre Rancho Corral de Tierra property, acquired by POST in 2001, that is due to become part of the Golden Gate National Recreation Area (GGNRA), said POST president Audrey Rust.

"This purchase helps complete an important and much larger conservation picture along this part of the San Mateo Coast," Ms. Rust said. "It provides new options to connect Rancho Corral de Tierra to surrounding protected lands and greatly expands opportunities for the region's network of scenic hiking trails."

In an agreement finalized Nov. 19, POST bought the ridge-top property for \$3 million from Daniel and Virginia Gregerson, who owned the land since the mid-1980s.
