Nurturing the family with home-baked bread

For many years, I baked sourdough bread almost every week — using kitchen alchemy to turn flour and water, plus a few spoonfuls of sugar and salt, into a fragrant, addictive treat my family couldn't get enough of.

Baking bread is a magical process — using yeast to turn mundane ingredients into something irresistible. But sourdough is even more magical because it manages, with enough patience, to make the dough rise and develop flavor using only airborne wild yeast.

Yeast, whether dried in a packet or captured from the air in a sourdough starter, is actually a living organism. When set loose in a damp, warm environment and mixed with flour, yeast works to break down the starch in flour into sugars that fuel fermentation.

Carbon dioxide, the bubbles that make the bread rise and develop its unique texture, and alcohol are produced, as well as some excess sugars that flavor the bread.

On Saturday nights I'd set out my sourdough starter, made from a bit of last week's dough, plus a little flour and water. Sunday mornings I'd add more flour, stir it up, and let it sit in a warm place. Soon the yeast, which had been trapped in the starter, set to work and the mixture began to bubble and foam and expand.

After lunch, I'd add some sugar and salt and more flour and turn the bubbly mixture into bread dough, using more bread-making magic. As bread dough is kneaded, either by hand or machine, proteins in the flour form gluten fibers that combine to change the mixture from a sticky, gloopy mess into a smooth and elastic whole.

After several more hours of rising, I'd knead out some of the gases and form the dough into loaves, which would take a few more hours to

What my friend Izzy Hillberg did for winter break By Katie Blankenberg

Do onto others, as you would have them do onto you. It was in that spirit that my friend and St. Raymond classmate, Isabelle Hillberg of Atherton, and her family went to Juarez, Mexico, for a few days in February during winter break.

In the outskirts of Juarez, Mexico, there are hundreds of thousands of people living in houses made of pallets, cardboard and other discarded material.

From Feb. 19 to 21, the Hillbergs joined approximately 10 other families from the Menlo Park Presbyterian Church community for a trip sponsored by Mission Ministries to Juarez, Mexico, lead by Scott Kline of the Juarez Children's Education Program. In total, about 48 people went to the outskirts of Juarez, half of them kids.

All members of the mis-

sionary had set up. The volunteers were split into three groups, with each group responsible for building one house for a needy family.

The schedule was rigorous, with volunteers working from 6:30 a.m. to 5:30 p.m., and with the future tenants working alongside them.

Isabelle's group was assigned to build a house with three rooms for a family with two parents and three children. The family was very nice, she said, and they were really excited to have a house to shelter them.

Each group started out with a just a few planks of wood. Isabelle's job was to cut holes for doors and windows. Some members of the group helped stand the planks together while others nailed them with nail guns and hammers.

The volunteers installed insulation, dry walls and the roof, and painted the walls.

Once construction was completed, the volunteers turned over the keys to the new tenants.

"The happiness and true joy on the

Woodside School relives Spanish Days

Have you ever tried to plan an event that will excite and intrigue a seventh-grader, a second-grader and a kindergartner all at once?

Woodside Elementary School's fourth grade did, and with its first annual California's Spanish Days project, they succeeded.

Each student looked in depth at a different aspect of California history, and created a project illustrating what they had learned about explorers, missionaries, and rancheros.

First-grader Jake Coslet hesitated, and surrounded by so many interesting choices, he finally wandered over to Kate McDowell's board game. Elsewhere, a few brave seventh graders risked being buzzed out by Andrew Piro's electronic quiz board.

At the same time, a group of children plopped themselves down on the floor to see Garrett Misselwitz's puppet show. Everywhere they turned, they could see costumed fourth-graders eager to talk about their character's life.

"This is a great example of project-based learning," says science teacher Bill Dolyniuk, who started the school's science fair 26 years ago. "You can teach the standards, but by taking ownership of their projects, students

end up going into the subject in greater depth, becoming more engaged in the topic, and thereby retaining more of the information."

It was clear that the students' enthusiasm was contagious. During the opening, when the fourth-graders sang "California Bound" and "Explorers, Missionaries, Rancheros" — a couple of original songs about California History — the upper graders in the audience began to clap along.

Later, some parents found themselves pulling back as younger children crowded the displays eager to ask questions of how models of missions, galleons and ranchos had been

constructed. They learned about cattle branding, and the types of food available to sailors and people living in the missions.

The "artifacts" in this temporary museum were amazing in their attention to detail. Cassie Miller displayed the mail carrier's pouch that she created to hold the "letters home" she wrote from the perspective of a boy following Junipero Serra. Another writer, Jessica Patton, made the paper for her journal detailing a girl's life in a mission.

Many of the students made movies. Brothers Frank and Austin Smith made a video of

keys is something that I will never forget," says Michele Hillberg, Isabelle's mother.

The total cost of each house was \$7,000, which was raised by donations. Isabelle even made a little doghouse for three abandoned puppies she found.

"This experience has changed my perspective on life because I know that life for many people is far from perfect," says Isabelle. "I now understand how hard it really is for some people to just survive and I realize how happy the people were to just have a house. My family and I are hoping to go back to Juarez again and build more houses."

Here mother calls it the "most fulfilling, soul-searching trip" she has ever taken.

"I have traveled through many countries

and seen the excess and poverty," she says. "This is the first time I have had the chance to interact directly with the people and help them one-on-one and side-by-side." ■

P.S. Unlike traditional rigid gas permeable contacts, hybrids are not prone to dislodging during strenuous activity. Hybrids are much less likely to gather debris underneath as well.

double in size.

The final bit of magic came when the loaves were put in the oven and the smell of fresh-baked bread began seducing my husband and children into the kitchen. We always quickly ate the first large loaf straight out of the oven, with maybe a little fruit jam smeared on.

I'd bake six loaves each week, putting a few into the freezer to preserve for our later-in-the-week meals or the weeks when I was too busy to bake.

My bread-baking routine was interrupted about eight years ago when we moved into our old farmhouse with a kitchen far too cramped for much baking. We planned to install a new kitchen designed with bread making in mind, including two big ovens.

Alas, while we were waiting for the new kitchen, my children grew up and started leaving home, my Sundays became filled with other activities, and my sourdough starter expired from neglect in my refrigerator.

A year or so ago, I tried getting a new starter going with a bit of dough from a local bakery. But nothing stays the same, and I found the old routine impossible to re-establish. My baguette pans sit unused in the cupboard, but, still, just thinking about the smell of fresh-baked bread makes me salivate. ■
