

# Lessons learned on PLAYING FIELD OF *Life*

Room 25 at Oak Knoll School in Menlo Park was empty this morning. Normally, the carefully orchestrated chaos of the classroom echoes through the school, but today it was quiet. And for a special reason.

Today, the six students, along with their teacher, three aides and nurse played hooky

to participate in the Northern California Special Olympics at Burlingame High School.

The Special Olympics has always been a highlight of the school year for Alex Ruth's kids, where disabled children from around the county get to compete

in races, jumps, and softball throws.

Nowhere else can you easily confuse a long jump participant with a sprinter. It's a track meet where finish lines don't necessarily mean the end of the race, as teachers often chase after kids almost into the parking lot and beyond.

It is a chance for beleaguered families around the Peninsula to gather and share their stories of the year. We have gathered in humble acceptance of what our children are, and what they aren't. Many look anx-

iously around to make sure that friends from years past are still there. Bonds forged in hospitals and doctor's offices rekindle amid the mayhem.

But this year, it wasn't just Room 25

that was empty. Joining them for the first year were their friends in Mrs. Murphy's second-grade class who also made the trek north to cheer on their buddies.

What could have been an awkward experience turned into a festival of fun.

The little "helpers" assisted the kids in many ways — they foot wedged a couple of the softball throws, they raced alongside the sprinters, providing moving targets for the kids to follow.

Others hopped like frogs to demonstrate proper technique for the long jumpers. But mostly, they screamed their hearts out for our special kids and always had a sturdy hand to offer when an overeager jumper toppled to the turf.

Mrs. Murphy's class learned a lesson not easily taught in the classroom. They experienced the simple truth that even "different" kids love the thrill of the race, even if they are not exactly sure which one they are in.

They learned that a race not run is worse than losing, and that some times just showing up is half the battle. They saw how far a little love and support goes. That a victory is measured by the smile on the face, not the medal around the neck.

By the end of the day, you couldn't really tell the difference between Mr. Ruth's or Mrs. Murphy's kids. They all meandered back to the cars, joined by the laughter of the day and memories of the events. What started off as two groups melded into one tired but elated team of winners.

So the classes were empty, but the lessons were still learned. Training has begun again for next year. ■

## MULTIPLE CHOICE? HARDLY A CHOICE ...

No longer is applying to college a short essay, one SAT, and sending a transcript. Today each application for college rivals a mortgage application, and the number of tests a person takes makes him feel as if he is trying to get a fighter pilot's license.

I am currently in the midst of applying to college, and have found it to be much more labor intensive than I had ever imagined (despite the warnings from my sibling). First, the SAT 1. It is but one of a plethora of tests that takes about five hours and consumes one's Saturday.

A student also has to take a minimum of

two SAT subject tests. SAT 2 tests aren't the regular SAT tests. They are much more in depth and test the material students have learned over all their school years. No longer can a kid get a great score just because he or she is good at reading passages about 18th century England.

Two SAT 2 tests are the minimum for many colleges, and some even insist on three! I personally took the SAT 2 exams for math and U.S. history. Countless hours of review and preparation consumed my life for weeks.

Think you're finished? Not quite yet. Many kids are opting to take the ACT test. I decided not to take the ACT because I cannot stand the thought of another test and still have my junior finals ahead of me.

And after these four or five tests, kids still have to take AP tests that are given by the College Board (the same people that bring you the SAT). These are radically in depth in each subject, and kids basically study all year for these through their

designated AP course.

Don't think I am the only one who believes the junior year is all about "alphabet tests."

Veé Dunlevie, a Sacred Heart high-school junior, told me: "I found the subject tests to be quite difficult. While the timing is not as crucial as it is in the SAT, many of the questions are obscure and hard to decipher. Compared to the AP tests that I have taken, I found the SAT subject tests are more challenging."

Another Sacred Heart junior, Katie Gallagher, said: "I went to a SAT prep course over the summer and it really helped me out with tactics on how to do better on the SATs. I highly suggest doing something like that."

So if you have an early high schooler or even a late middle-schooler, get them started on the process now for studying for all these tests, so they don't end up spending the entire summer before their junior year making sure they can identify a parallel structure error in the grammar section on the SAT. ■
