Well Preserved

We think of home canning as a grandma thing. Picture granny hunched over a pot of splattering jam, shooin' kids and flies out of the steamy kitchen on a hot August afternoon.

Years ago, canning wasn't a choice for homemakers, it was a necessity. Trees on the land were heavy with fruit. The garden was ripe with produce that couldn't wait. If the family was going to eat well in the coming winter, the harvest had to be preserved.

The fruits of that labor were stored in the basement or fruit cellar. It was a point of pride to display gleaming jars of red tomatoes, green pickles, jewel-colored jams and jellies.

Gudrun Enger channels her 'inner grandma' when it comes to home canning

Nostalgia for earlier times led Gudrun Enger of Menlo Park to make her first foray into home canning. "My two grandmas and my mom were all into freezing and canning," she says. As a child, she went with her mother to U-pick farms near Watsonville to pick olallieberries for jam.

When her own son was a baby, she continued the tradition. "I put him in a backpack, and headed to a U-pick farm. I made olallieberry jam and gave away most of it to my friends."

That was the beginning. When a colleague at work at Stanford University brought in plums, she made plum jam. A couple of

years later, she turned green tomatoes from her garden into green tomato mincemeat.

"We use it for pies at Thanksgiving," she says. She found the mincemeat recipe in the 1963 "Freezing and Canning Cookbook."

Preserving tomatoes and bread and butter pickles are now part of her repertoire. "Last year I did 40 pounds of tomatoes in quart and pint jars." She orders roma tomatoes from the local Community Supported Agriculture (CSA), a service that also delivers a weekly box of produce to her home.

"Canned tomatoes are so high in sodium, I like to put up my own," she says.

The home-canned tomatoes are often used as a base for marinara sauce.

Peaches for jam and pickling cucumbers are purchased at Webb Ranch in Portola Valley. In high season, Webb also sells canning tomatoes at a lower price.

Ms. Enger was making peach jam with ginger on the day we visited. She also added black pepper. "I like to experiment in my cooking," she says. She also makes nectarine jam flavored with vanilla bean.

She uses no pectin in the jam, so it takes longer to cook. "I like the flavor and color when using a long-cooking method. The peaches seem to caramelize."

Her basic jam recipe uses 5-1/2 to 6 cups of fruit to 4 to 5 cups of sugar and 2 table-

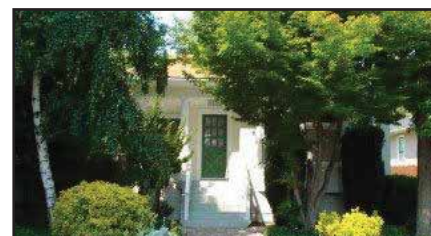

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spoons of lemon juice. It yields 6 to 7 pints of jam.

The hot jam is poured into sterilized glass jars. Metal lids, which have been simmered in hot water, are fastened on with bands. The jars are turned upside down for five minutes and then flipped back, she says.

Ms. Enger buys canning jars at Orchard Supply and other canning tools, such as a canning kettle and jar lifter, at Palo Alto Hardware.

"Oh, that sounds so hard" is the reaction she often gets when telling friends about home canning. "So far, I haven't managed to convert anyone," she says with a laugh.

Fruits of her labor. Home-canned jars of tomatoes, quince, bread and butter pickles, and plum jam will bring a taste of summer to winter meals.

They do, however, appreciate gifts from her kitchen. One year she made so much plum jam "I had to force it on friends," she says.

There are many Web sites with home canning information. Ms. Enger likes the National Center for Home Food Preservation, part of the University of Georgia. "They've got everything," she says.

The Web site www.freshpreserving.com also has step-by-step information for home canners. The site is operated by Ball Corp., manufacturers of glass canning jars. Ball also publishes the Ball Blue Book Guide to Preserving and the Ball Complete Book of Home Preserving.

As people plant more gardens or buy local produce, there's a resurgence in home canning. Gardeners want to preserve the fruits and vegetables they worked to raise. Good cooks like the creativity that making jam or canning pickles affords them.

Ms. Enger is part of the new wave of home canners who find that making something with their own hands is satisfying and tastes better than anything they can buy. Home canning, once thought to be old-fashioned, now is considered cool. **A**

New market cafe features cheese and wine tasting in downtown Menlo Park

Wine and cheese fanciers will soon have another local venue for exploring new goods with the arrival of GC's Tasting Cafe and Specialty Market in downtown Menlo Park.

The shop is expected to open sometime this month at 657 Oak Grove Ave., according to co-owner Carl Rabe. The shop will offer cheese tasting all day long, and will begin pouring wine for tasting beginning at 3 p.m., Mr. Rabe says.

It will also serve deli-style foods to eat on the premises or to take out, such as sandwiches, soups and salads. And — good news for chocolate lovers — the cafe will feature chocolate and cheese fondues, Mr. Rabe promises.

GC's will be a family affair: Mr. Rabe's two business partners are also his brothers-in-

law, Gerrard Culas and Bruce Tomlinson. "And our kids are going to be working there, and significant others will be working there, too," he says.

"Our main focus will be on cheese," Mr. Rabe says, adding that most will be European, but the shop will also carry some cheeses from California.

There will be about 100 wines, with a focus on the Santa Cruz Mountain and Central Coast regions, he says.

Patrons will be able to call upon the expertise of Mr. Culas, who was a cheese-maker in his native France, when exploring the many cheeses available at GC's. Mr. Tomlinson, the CFO of a major company, is the financials man for the enterprise.

Mr. Rabe says his interest in launching the new business is grounded in 27 years of working in retail, particularly his experience at Safeway.

In naming the shop, the

owners chose the word "tasting" with serious intentions: In addition to wine and cheese, customers will be able to taste olive and other types of oils, soups, and other items on the menu, Mr. Rabe says.

GC's will host single-winery tastings on Saturdays, with the winery owner or winemaker present, he says, adding that the first two events will feature David Bruce wines (Santa Cruz Mountains appellation) and Michaud wines (Chalone appellation).

The owners plan to launch GC's, in the combined spaces formerly occupied by Cindy's Flowers and Menlo Colonial Chapel, with an ambitious schedule, Mr. Rabe says. The shop will be open seven days a week, from 6 a.m. to 8 p.m. Monday through Saturday, and from 10 a.m. to 3 p.m. Sundays. There will be coffee and pastries for the early birds, and eventually, the cafe may offer crepes and waffles in the morning as well, he says.

RESOLUTION OF INTENTION TO ANNEX CERTAIN TERRITORY TO THE WEST BAY SANITARY DISTRICT ON-SITE WASTEWATER DISPOSAL ZONE

LANDS OF SALAH

The District Board of West Bay Sanitary District finds and determines as follows:

A. This Resolution of Intention is adopted pursuant to the District's "Zone Master Annexation Resolution" ("ZOMAR"), which was adopted by the District Board on August 12, 1996. The provisions of ZOMAR are incorporated by reference into this Resolution of Intention.

B. The District has received an application to annex parcel of real property (the "Parcel") to the District's On-Site Wastewater Disposal Zone (the "Zone"). The Parcel is described in Exhibit "A" attached to this Resolution of Intention and the description contained in the Exhibit is incorporated by reference. The name and address of the applicants and the number, type, volume and location of on-site wastewater disposal systems which are proposed to operate on the parcel to be annexed are described in Exhibit "B" attached to this Resolution of Intention and the information contained in the Exhibit is incorporated by reference.

C. The applicant has demonstrated to the satisfaction of the District Board that the Parcel constitutes "real property" for the purposes of Section 2(b) of ZOMAR in that:

- All of the conditions described in Subsections i., ii., iii., iv. and v. of ZOMAR Section 2(b) are satisfied; or

Other conditions exist which demonstrate that the Parcel will benefit directly or indirectly from the activities of the Zone. If applicable, those conditions are also set forth in Exhibit "B" and are incorporated by reference.

D. All of the conditions and requirements of ZOMAR Sections 2(a), 2(c), 2(d) and 2(e) have been fully satisfied.

In consideration of the foregoing findings and determinations,

IT IS RESOLVED by the District Board as follows:

1. It is the intention of the District Board to annex the Parcel to the Zone pursuant to the provisions of ZOMAR and applicable provisions of law.
2. In conjunction with a meeting of the District Board to be duly and regularly called and conducted, the Board will conduct a Public Hearing for the purpose of considering all matters pertaining to this Resolution of Intention.

5. The District Manager shall cause the matters set forth in Sections 3 and 4 of this Resolution of Intention to be completed as directed.

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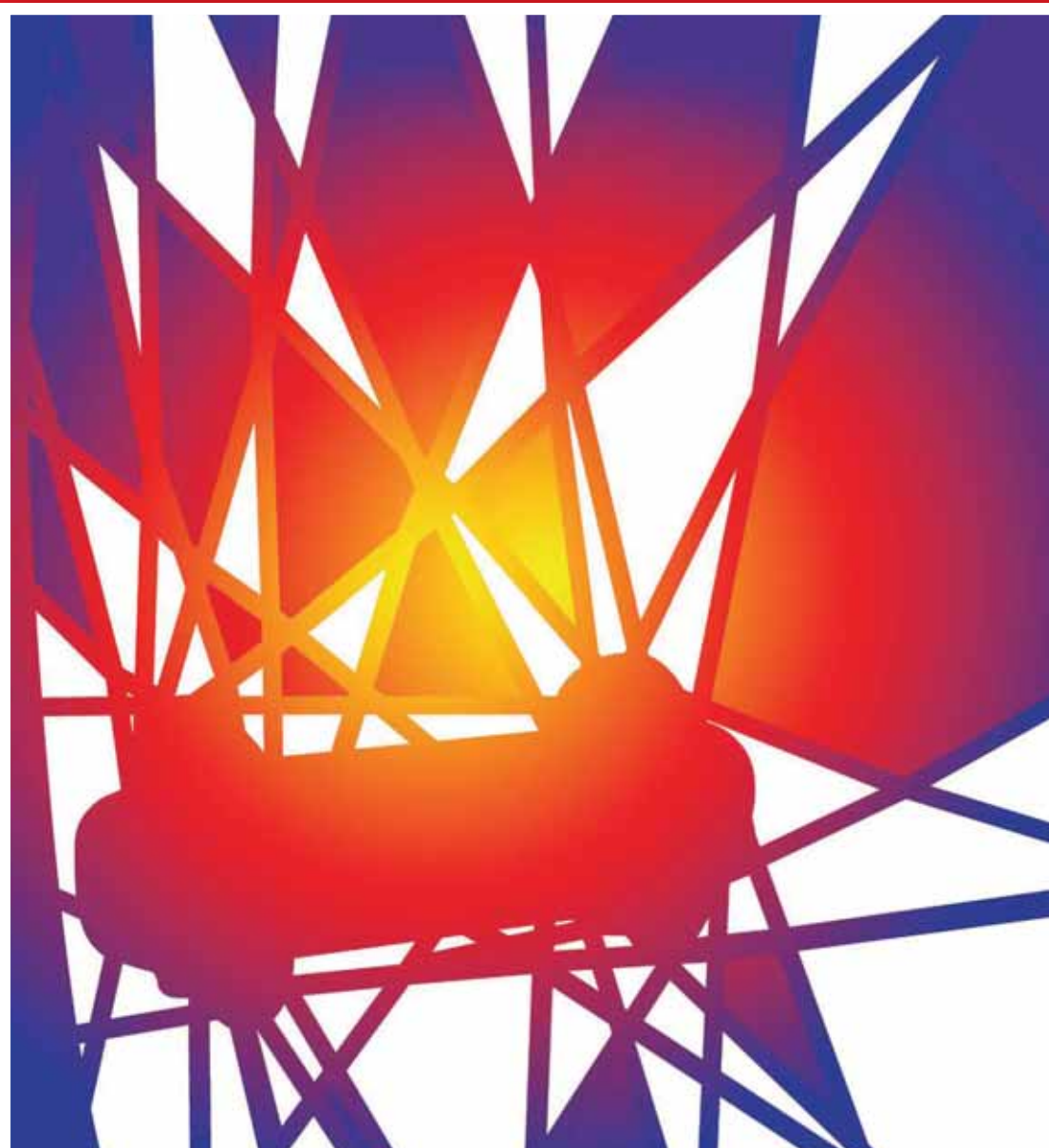
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The Sequoias celebrates new facilities Aug. 9

Old age can take many paths: robust health until your last day, a comfortable life punctuated by visits to the hospital, a slow decline into dementia, a surprise diagnosis followed by rapid demise.

The Sequoias retirement community of about 310 people in Portola Valley is celebrating completion of an expansion project that includes three new facilities designed to address the more difficult turns of life, while continuing the tradition of offering apartments for independent living.

A celebration and tour of the new facilities is set for Saturday, Aug. 9, from 2 to 4:30 p.m. at The Sequoias, located at 501 Portola Road, resident Trish Hooper said in an e-mail message.

The Sequoias offers a full life, said Bob Rutherford, a resident and the master of ceremonies for the event. "A full life means that a person lives here and their lives progress from one step to another. It's all here," he said. "The (facilities) themselves, now that they're done, become unimportant. It is what happens within them that's important."

The Lodge, which opened in November 2007, offers assisted living for 26 on two floors, each with its own kitchen. Residents can outfit their rooms with their own furniture, Mr. Rutherford said.

The windows look out on Windy Hill, and the facility includes a gym, a beauty shop and a massage room, Ms. Hooper said.

The Health Center, a small hospital, was "totally remodeled," Mr. Rutherford said. Its 43 beds include 13 private rooms and 15 double-occupancy rooms.

A third building, the former Lodge, is now called The Gardens and will offer living arrangements for 18 people suffering from dementia, Mr. Rutherford said. It's scheduled to open this month.

The Gardens includes a secure "wander" garden for afflicted residents, Ms. Hooper said.

Residents contributed \$8.5 million to the \$32 million project, Mr. Rutherford said.

For independent residents, the celebration inaugurates a par-course exercise trail available to all Portola Valley residents, including "couch potatoes," if any, Ms. Hooper said. ▀

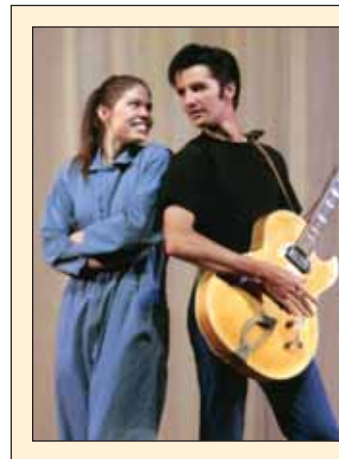

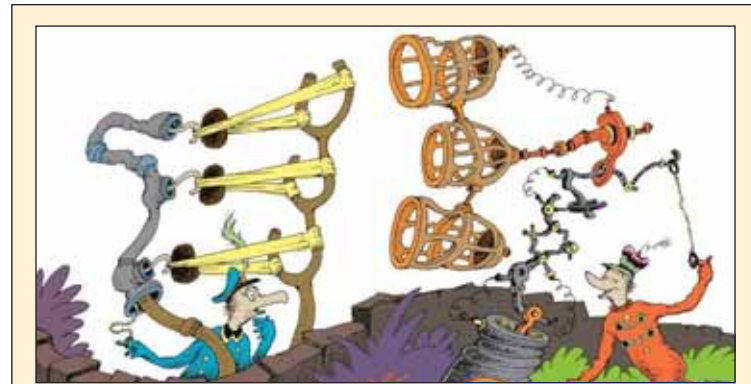
