## A JOURNEY OF HOPE —

# One stitch at a time

It's no surprise that Dr. Annette Chavez is an ace with a needle and thread. A surgeon at Kaiser Permanente in Santa Clara for 19 years, she engages in her specialized handiwork daily in service to her patients.

But Dr. Chavez, a 28-year Menlo Park resident, doesn't limit the use of her needlework skills to the operating room, as anyone who steps into her

office will quickly realize. On a large wall across from her desk hangs a striking, handmade quilt — bordered and accented in pink, and featuring messages that convey the hopes and appreciation of about 40 women who have battled breast cancer.

Dr. Chavez, who began quilting about 13 years ago when her two sons were young

and she found herself at home more often, said she had long wanted to make a quilt with the names of breast cancer patients and survivors. She knows many of them: As assistant chief of the Department of Surgery at Kaiser, she specializes in breast surgery as well as laparoscopic and endocrine surgery.

She began with the idea of asking Kaiser breast cancer

patients and former patients to sign patches for a traditional quilt that she would stitch together. "Signature quilts have been around for centuries," she explains. "They've been made for ... special events in people's lives and presented as gifts."

But the project took on a life of its own. "People came in and were not only signing their names, they were leaving mes-

last year, Dr. Chavez enlisted the help of Esther Duran, a physician assistant and the hospital's breast cancer coordinator.

Ms. Duran took charge of contacting women who had been diagnosed with breast cancer that year. She brought in materials for participants to create their own 4-inch squares, which were then attached to a piece of flannel cloth on a wall

sages — and they are powerful," Dr. Chavez says. "So it morphed into this message of hope."

Now titled "A Journey of Hope (2007)," the quilt will soon be hung in a case in the hospital's surgery clinic — the first in what promises to be a series of such quilts.

### Launching the project

Once she decided the time was right to dive into a quilt project

in Dr. Chavez's office.

Ms. Duran also contributed the first square to the quilt: She is a 15-year survivor of breast cancer, offering "a special insight" when counseling newly diagnosed patients, Dr. Chavez notes.

Other contributors got into the spirit of the project by leaving upbeat comments, most ending in joyful exclamation

marks:

"I had breast cancer — It didn't have me!!!

"With hope, faith and family I made it!!

"You can get thru this. Never give up."

"We're all thinking of you and your courageous fight!"

"If I can, you can!"

"Adversity is a part of life ... but life is good!!

As more and more women contributed messages as well as their names, Dr. Chavez realized her original "signature quilt" idea would have to make way for a larger theme. "When you're in here [in the office] with these messages, it's really moving," she says.

When she designed the quilt, she culled four thematic words from the women's messages to center the work: hope, faith, love, life.

She then worked on placing the messages in the quilt to make a symmetrical work of art, with some of her friends coming by to offer comments and suggestions. "Quilting is a very social activity," Dr. Chavez says. "Everyone weighs in — there's always a community around it."

### "Something to hang on to"

The quilt's title, "A Journey of Hope," is also "the message that we try to convey to our patients with breast cancer," Dr. Chavez writes in an e-mail — after dashing away from an early morning interview to deal with a crisis in the hospital's intensive care unit.

"Although many women are diagnosed with the disease, the majority are cured and go on to lead normal lives," she adds. "However, at the time of diagnosis, the prevailing thought is, 'I

am going to die.'

"Unfortunately, most of us have known many friends and family members (who) have died from cancer, and it terrifies them. They need something to hang on to when they undergo this life-changing event."

Dr. Chavez hopes the quilt will "encourage and comfort these women and let them know they're not alone."

The women who contributed to the quilt "are sharing what got them through their ordeals," Dr. Chavez notes. "The responses are myriad, but there are common themes ... It seems trite, but these are the times when a person re-evaluates (her) life and realizes what is most important." Those things tend to include family and "for many, their faith in God," she says.

"Not one of these patients listed a bigger house or a diamond ring as things that got them through their treatment!"

### Support at home

Family is important to Dr. Chavez, too. She speaks proudly of her twin sons, Michael and Daniel, 17-year-old seniors at Menlo-Atherton High School, and notes that they and her husband, Greg Fountain, "are very supportive of my quilting."

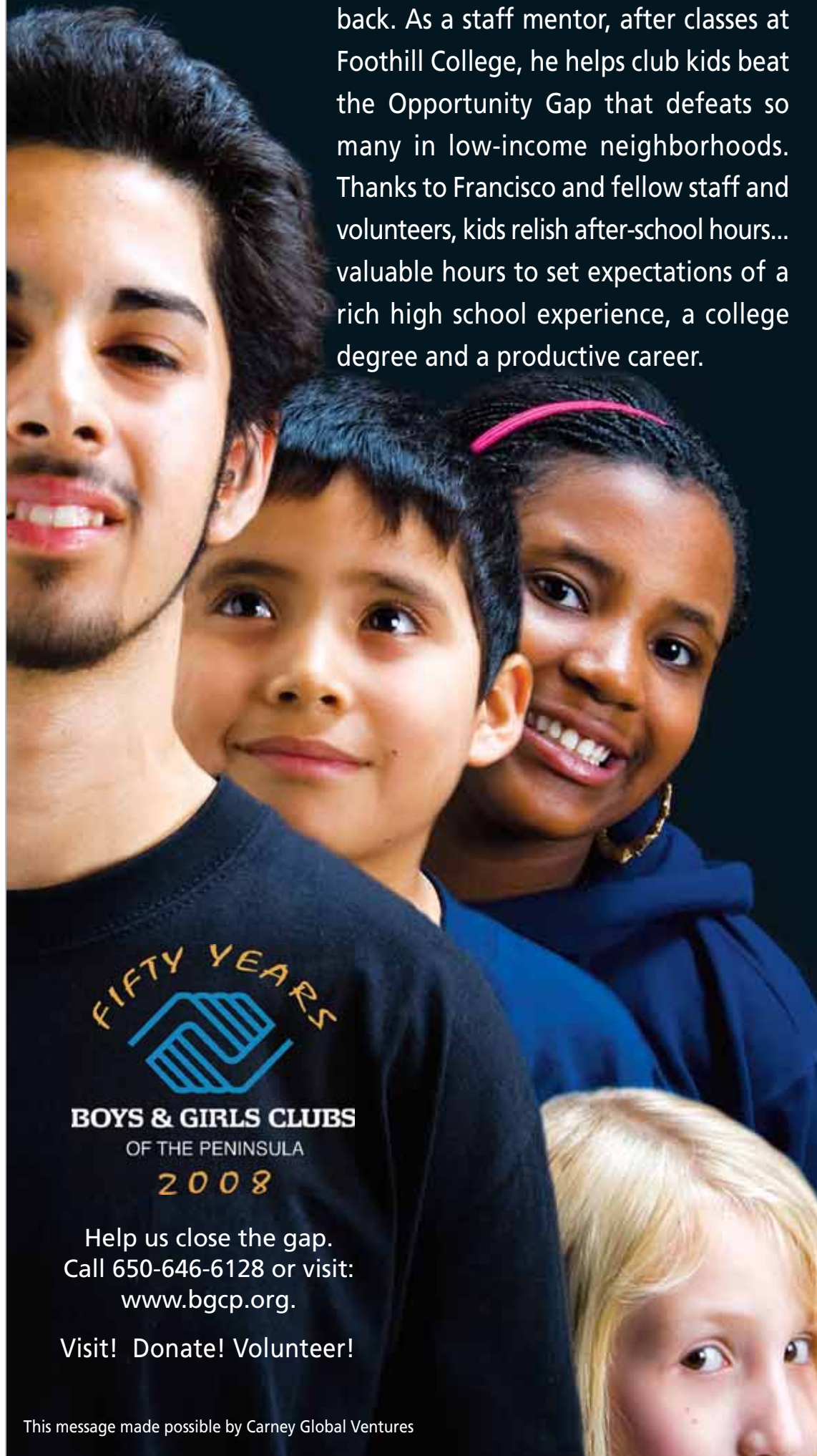
The boys, she says, "have helped me make quilts for some of their teachers in the past. I spent many hours at basketball games working on my quilt squares!"

In addition to her work at Kaiser, Dr. Chavez is a clinical associate professor of surgery at Stanford.

True to her calling as an educator, Dr. Chavez emphasizes the importance of early detection of cancer. In a recent e-mail to this writer, she signs off: "Take care, and please get your mammogram if you have not had one in the last year." ■

## All stressed up and too many places to go

Stress makes us fat. Or at the very least, packs on a few extra pounds, and during this time of year we need extra sleep, not extra pounds. From Thanksgiving to New Year's Day, the average holiday weight gain is six pounds. Not exactly the "six pack" we want to be sporting around the midsection.

Maneuvering our chardonnay glass between buffet tables and crab puffs while trying to dodge the dessert table is no easy feat, especially in a pair of stilettos or a too-tight tux. We once thought it was just the fruitcake and cookies that gave way to our muffin top, but there is another culprit at play — stress.

There are several ways in which stress contributes to weight gain, and the stress hormone cortisol is at the top of the list. When under stress, the fight-or-flight response is triggered, leading to the release of various hormones, including cortisol. The shift in our metabolism is experienced through a burst of energy needed to fight or run like heck.

But modern-day stress most often takes place in a cubicle or SUV, not while slaying a *T. rex*. We sit physically passive but emotionally active — in other words, the fight without the flight — and that's a recipe for disease, illness, and weight gain.

The same response occurs when we are bubbling up inside as we dash from holiday school play, to company party, to wrapping, writing, and wrangling our presents, cards, and kids. It's enough to make anyone hit The Wine Room in Palo Alto well before an appropriate hour.

But don't despair: There are ways to reduce stress and still enjoy your festivities. I call them the Big O's: Organize, Omit, Own, Outside, and Organic.

**Organize:** This is not clean-

out-your-closet organize; this is "make a list and check it twice" organizing. Use a notebook and make a master list of what you want to accomplish, then organize it by week, then day. Stick to your list, and be sure to include white space — nothing planned except spontaneity.

**Omit:** When you start saying "yes" too many times, your white space disappears. Omit the extras. It's OK to stop at Sprinkles for the classroom party treats instead of baking until midnight.

**Own:** Own your time, don't give it away. Remember, peace of mind is not spelled p-i-e-c-e.

**Outside:** Get outside and move. Moving promotes healthy blood flow needed to oxygenate your muscles and keep you relaxed.

**Organic:** Organic is meant not only for the foods we eat, but for who we are and how we live. Try to remember your own natural flow. If you like to exercise in the morning, schedule your holiday events in the afternoon — that is one way to protect your own personal "organic" self. Allow the holidays to have an organic feel by including everyday activities that make you feel relaxed rather than rushed. And as always, buy and eat organic foods whenever possible. ### AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MENLO PARK ADDING CHAPTER 2.42 [PURCHASING SYSTEM] TO TITLE 2 [ADMINISTRATION AND PERSONNEL] OF THE MENLO PARK MUNICIPAL CODE TO PROVIDE FOR BIDDING PROCEDURES FOR PUBLIC PROJECTS UNDER THE UNIFORM PUBLIC CONSTRUCTION COST ACCOUNTING ACT

- The Ordinance establishes procedures for bidding for public projects under the Uniform Public Construction Accounting Act, and changes some of the bidding procedures and limits of authority set forth in Administrative Policy #FIN 2001-001, "Purchasing Policies and Procedures," dated March 16, 2001, and Council Policy #CC-92-04, "Award Authority for Purchases and Professional Services," Resolution No. 4354, dated March 17, 1992.
