"Menlo School Airlines ... the only way to fly" is the theme of the school's 59th annual benefit. The invitation shows a passenger seated in a DC-3 flying over the Menlo School campus.

Printed tickets (remember those?) list the cost of lunch booking (\$100) and evening booking (\$200). The "ticket and boarding documents" show Menlo seniors taking off on Flight 2009 as their parents wave farewell from Douglas Hall.

The invitation was designed by Menlo student Katie Howard. Originally the benefit committee asked artist and designer Tom Suiter to help them design a "look." Mr. Suiter wanted to involve students in

the project and worked with studio art students Katie Howard, Jack Suiter and Carter Boyce to develop the concept.

Katie says: "I came up with the idea for a ticket, Carter thought of the plane, and Jack thought of the passport. We all worked three or four weeks and presented our ideas to the benefit chairs."

Co-chairs are parents Kathy Diekroeger of Woodside and Betsy Baum of Hillsborough. The Menlo School community and more than 150 parents have spent nearly a year planning the event, with proceeds going to the school's financial aid program.

"Menlo 9 Takes Flight" will be held

in a "hangar" (tented area) on the Menlo School campus with some 1,600 guests expected to attend lunch and/or dinner. Boarding for the luncheon is scheduled for 11:30 a.m. and the evening party begins at 6 p.m. Both the luncheon and dinner include "in-flight" entertainment, including a fashion show put on by Bloomingdale's and entertainment vignettes.

Guests will fasten their seatbelts as they await the donation drawing, this year featuring a 2009 Piaggio Scooter

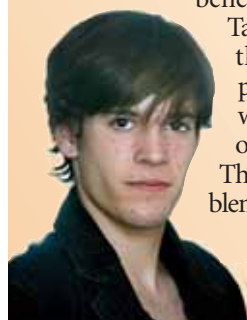

## MENLO SENIOR WRITES ORIGINAL MUSIC FOR SCHOOL BENEFIT

**W**hen Menlo School seniors take to the stage Friday, March 20, at the beginning of the school's annual benefit, "Menlo 9 Takes Flight," the triumphal music will be by one of their own. The celebratory blending of brass, strings and percussion is an origi-



nal composition by Menlo senior, Niko Korolog.

"We were thrilled when Niko suggested he compose a piece for the production," says Alex Perez, Menlo's creative arts director. "He is an enormous talent." For the occasion, Mr. Perez suggested Niko create a "grand march" in the style of John Williams.

Niko, 18, who has been composing since the eighth grade, produced the recording using a computer program call "Digital Performance." A demo of the music, paired with a video clip of flying airplanes, was shown to the benefit committee. They loved it.

Niko, the son of Diana and George Korolog of Redwood City, began piano lessons when he was in first grade. He has studied voice, piano and composition. Today he plays piano and "a little bit of drums." His brother, Phillip, is also musical and plays guitar.

Planning to major in music in college, Niko sees his future in composing, not performing. Which college? He's not yet decided.

Niko began composing as part of a project when he was in eighth grade at Nueva Day School in Hillsborough. He says

composing is "very simple. It's like a puzzle, a puzzle that you set up for yourself. Every time you complete one (composition), there's always another one waiting for you."

His musical education includes composition classes at the San Francisco Conservatory of Music; weekly private composition and theory study with Alexis Aldridge, director of John Adams Young Composers Program; five-week sessions at the Walden School of Music in New Hampshire in 2006 and 2007; and advanced placement music theory at Menlo School.

He has played in the Menlo School Jazz Band and now plays keyboard with his own band, Pyro Scout, whose other members are Clarissa Coultas, Jessi Bauer and Geoffrey Pleiss. Pyro Scout has played for Menlo School events.

Looking to the future, Niko hopes to write music for films and video games, and has already written original music soundtracks for several films. "I wouldn't even mind doing commercials," he says.

Niko is more than music. He has taken and enjoyed engineering classes at Menlo. "I like anything hands-on," he says. "I'm the one who fixes things around the house." ■

## Joining hands to help kids

Equine center teams with AchieveKids to serve missions of both organizations

Even though I have lived in Menlo Park and Portola Valley my whole life, I still come across great charitable organizations that are just under the radar for many people.

Recently, my editor asked me to write a story about the truly amazing work of a Woodside nonprofit called the Nation Center for Equine Facilitated Therapy (NCEFT).

This organization employs creative "therapy on horseback" techniques — using the movement of horses to provide physical and occupational therapy, for example — to help people of all ages with disabilities that impair their movement or social skills.

The NCEFT is involved in a creative partnership with a Palo Alto nonprofit called AchieveKids, which helps provide, among other things, vocational skills for youth with emotional or developmental disabilities.

More on that later. First, let me tell you more about the NCEFT.

The center has been around for 37 years. Two years ago it moved to a 12-acre property at 880 Runnymede Road in Woodside.

When I first arrived at NCEFT, I was astonished by the gorgeous, serene property. In this spacious arena, very well trained horses are used to help people of all ages with their mobility and their social skills. In most cases, patients are referred by their physical therapy physicians, though some come by word of mouth, says Gari Merendino,

executive director since 2007.

One strategy used to help patients with impaired movement is a treatment called hippotherapy. In hippotherapy, a person rides on a horse and adjusts his or her body position to match the gait of the horse, as if the rider were walking. Not only can this improve strength, posture and mobility, but it can help with speech disorders that occur with many mental and sometimes physical diseases, Mr. Merendino says.

Hippotherapy promotes speaking skills by having the patient command a horse and learn the effects of his or her words, such as "stop" or "go."

Besides hippotherapy, there is an Interactive Vaulting Program, a sport activity in a group setting with horses, for people with special needs who do not have enough core strength or posture for normal mobility; a Therapeutic Riding Program that helps patients build more self-esteem by creating a bond with a horse; and the Veterans Program, which offers rehabilitation services to those in the armed services and to veterans.

Since the NCEFT is a nonprofit organization, it has to raise money to keep operating and provide financial assistance

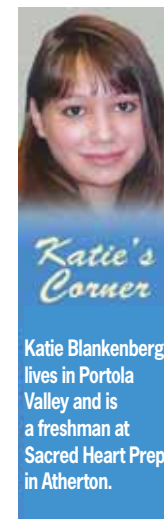
to patients who can't afford the programs. There are a number of great fundraisers coming up.

On July 11, the NCEFT Annual Ride-A-Thon Poker Ride will be held. It is similar to the walks for breast cancer and other causes, except it involves people riding or walking with their horses through Huddart County Park in Woodside. Other fundraisers, such as the NCEFT Gala Event and concerts, will be held later in the year.

### AchieveKids

The partnership with AchieveKids serves the missions of both organizations. Kids from AchieveKids go to the NCEFT to do any work that needs to be done. Currently, these kids are helping with the fundraiser called Path of Dreams, which involves people

## A whole new way to waste our time

I've always considered myself an "early adopter" of new technology. After all, in the 1980s I owned an Osborne "portable" computer about the size and shape of a sewing machine and played computer games like "Rogue," which consisted of x's and o's, navigated through by using the arrow keys on the keyboard.



But a few months ago, when I started getting e-mails from friends urging me to join the online social network, Facebook, I resisted.

I knew my children used Facebook and probably didn't want their mother there. Even though all three are now officially adults at the ages of 18, 21 and 23, I figured my joining Facebook might be seen by them as the equivalent of my showing up for a concert by their favorite band. (Which never will happen, because not only do I not know their favorite bands, I'm not even sure what the type of music they like is called.)

A few days ago I gave in, though, when the daughter in New York sent me a link to a video of her new cat she had posted on Facebook. I had to join so I could see it. Besides, I figured that a good rule for posting things on the Internet should probably be: "Never put anything up you wouldn't want your mother to see."

The next day I logged in to see what I had gotten myself into. The site offered to search my e-mail address book for people I

knew who were members of Facebook and ask them to become my "friends." Within a few hours I had a dozen "friends."

It was raining, so I couldn't work in the garden; instead I decided to post some photos of last summer's camping trip on my page. Then, some photos of my new dog. Then, just to make it fair, I posted photos of my old dog, too. Then, because my children sometimes seem jealous of the dog, I posted photos of the family.

As new "friends" joined my page, I checked out their "friends" and added some of them. I joined a group called "For All Those People who live in the small town of Woodside ... CA!!" I didn't think they had enough photos of my town, so I added a few of my favorites, and then a few more.

There were, I found, lots of "grown-ups" on Facebook. But very soon it became apparent that I could waste a huge amount of time there. It kept sending me e-mails saying I had new "friends" and when it did, I just had to check out their pages and look at the photos they had posted.

Finally, because I had to serve dinner very soon, I turned off the computer.

But the next day, it was raining even harder, so ... I created a Facebook page for the dog. Check it out — search for Wheeler Wood Fitzpatrick. He could use more friends.

buying a brick and having a message or name inscribed on it.

The bricks will be installed in front of the NCEFT arena. So far, the organization has raised about \$9,000. Instead of paying to get them inscribed, NCEFT is working with an AchieveKids job coach, who is a brick mason and will do the inscriptions for them.

Also, the brick mason will teach the youth from AchieveKids how to install the bricks in front of the arena.

"Given the tough economic times, you have two nonprofit organizations working together to support one another, while

accomplishing their core missions, controlling cost and making certain the money donated to both organizations is used effectively," says Mr. Merendino. "With our youth the beneficiaries."

NCEFT is supported by many generous volunteers and, of course, the 13 trained horses that stay at the center.

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# Charlotte Muse reads from new collection of poems

Eight decades ago, a dying woman breathed new life into a vanishing world — that of the native Mutsun tribe of Indians who lived in the central coastal region of California.

The last known fluent speaker of the Mutsun language, Ascención Solorsano de Cervantes spent the last months of her life, in 1929 and 1930, telling the stories of her ancestors, who helped build the mission at San Juan Bautista, and of the Mutsun culture. Those stories were written down by a prominent ethnologist of the times.

Now, local poet Charlotte Muse is giving Dona Ascención's words another life with her col-

lection, "A Story Also Grows," a series of poems that riff on hand-picked gems of storytelling gleaned from Smithsonian ethnologist John Peabody Harrington's transcript of his conversations with the dying woman.

Ms. Muse, who lives with husband and fellow poet Patrick Daly in the Willows neighborhood of Menlo Park, will read from the collection on Thursday, March 19, at Kepler's bookstore.

A former creative writing and poetry writing instructor at San Francisco State University, Ms. Muse said she was fascinated by the Solorsano stories after a friend shared with her a copy of the Harrington transcript found at the Stanford library. After

reading some of them, she says, she started writing a poem based on an excerpt that particularly struck her. "Then I just got into it," she says.

"I loved the stories — they had so much life to them," she adds.

The passages chosen for the collection present a variety of themes: from Dona Ascención's grandfather who, as a 12-year-old boy, spent days lowered into a pit digging a well for the mission, to a medicine man who "used to turn into a cat, a coyote, a fox, and a great horned owl."

The poetry is haunting and rich in imagery; the poet imagines the world and people that

fueled Dona Ascención's musings. In doing so, Ms. Muse says, she "tried to make (what she described) authentic. I tried not to trespass."

Although many of the poems reflect the beauty and spirit of a lost way of life, Ms. Muse doesn't shy away from the uglier stories, including the telling of a practice of horrific cruelty

to women who refused to give themselves to men, and recollections of battles between great horned owls and the men who tormented them.

"I consider it patronizing to romanticize Indians, just as it's patronizing to romanticize our own culture," she says.

Nor does she romanticize the Spanish missionaries who came to California and subjugated the native people; she notes at the end of the poem, "Digging at Night," that in 1812 alone, 1,179 Indians died of cholera and smallpox at Mission San Juan Bautista. The poem centers on the Solorsano quote, "The Indians were working digging a ditch ... day and night. And what do you think, Death was there too, working along with them, with her head tied up ..."

## Anderson reads from 'Mrs. Ramsay's knee'

Idris Anderson will read from her May Swenson Poetry Award-winning collection, "Mrs. Ramsay's Knee," during a joint program with poet Charlotte Muse at 7:30 p.m. Thursday, March 19, at Kepler's bookstore in Menlo Park.

The book is Ms. Anderson's first, but poetry lovers have known her work through publication in the *Paris Review*, the *Hudson Review*, the *Nation*, the *Southern Review*, and other magazines and journals.

Literary critic and scholar Harold Bloom chose "Mrs. Ramsay's Knee" for the Swenson award, and notes in the book's foreword that Ms. Anderson teases from the visual "what can be seen as an intimation at once immanent and transcendental."

Many of the poems are reflections on visual works of art, as well as on photographs from the 2006 Israeli/Hezbollah war in Lebanon. The poems are "essentially about intimacy of all kinds," Ms. Anderson says. "I'm interested in the desire for intimacy and the failures of intimacy on a personal as well as on an international level. War to me is an extreme failure of intimacy, of empathy."

A former Menlo Park resident, Ms. Anderson lives in San Carlos and is head of the English Department of Crystal Springs Uplands School.

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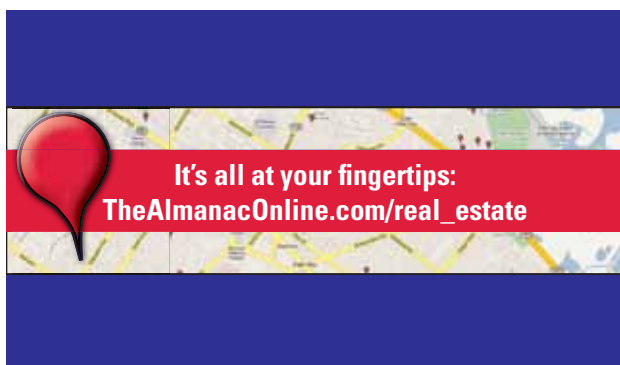

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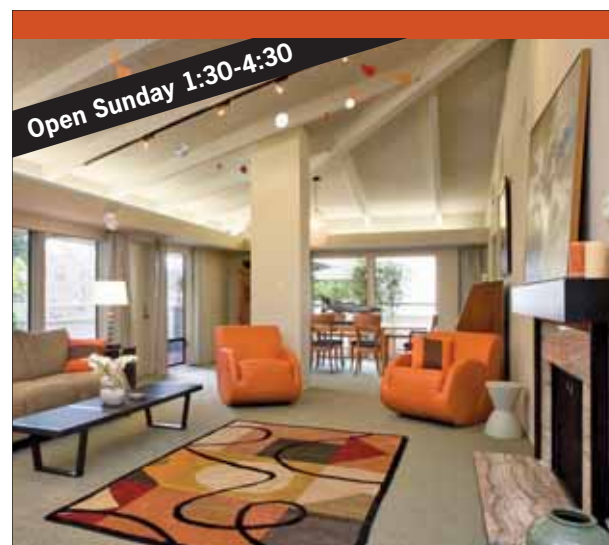
