# A parade of playhouses

A one-of-a-kind playhouse auction will benefit Rebuilding Together Peninsula

In hard times, it's still possible to have "Dreams Happen." That's the hope of Rebuilding Together Peninsula regarding its "Dreams Happen" auction and benefit, set for Saturday, June 6, at the Stanford Shopping Center.

Fifteen one-of-a-kind, life-size children's playhouses, now on display at the shopping center, will be featured at the auction. They range from "little e," an environmentally modern design from Dwell Magazine, featuring solar panels, to "Shark House," created in the spirit of hockey mania, with the support of the San Jose Sharks Foundation.

Gary Ahern of Woodside is playhouse chairman. An architect and owner of Focal Point Design, he has been building "dream houses" since 1999. This year, for his fifth playhouse, he designed "La Casita Bonita," a charming Spanish hacienda with tile roof, wrought iron staircase, and flower-filled window box.

Mr. Ahern's mini-rendition of the Ahwahnee Hotel at Yosemite, which sold for \$70,000 in 2005, stands as the auction's top

moneymaker.

Other playhouses on display this year include a firehouse, a lighthouse, a schoolhouse, and a "spy lair." A rugged "Coyote Creek Outpost" has been created by professional playhouse designer Barbara Butler. This past year Ms. Butler also refurbished a playhouse that a family had outgrown. It was then donated to a nonprofit in East Palo Alto, says Mr. Ahern.

The playhouses, all designed, built and donated by Bay Area architects and builders, raise money for Rebuilding Together,

formerly Christmas in April, which works with low-income, elderly and disabled residents to renovate their homes.

Nearly 3,000 Rebuilding Together volunteers were out in force April 25 to work on 49 homes and 21 community facilities in San Mateo and northern Santa Clara counties. Over the past 20 years, the organization's volunteer efforts have improved more than 1,200 homes and facilities. The services are provided at no charge to the beneficiaries.

Nonprofit organizations, churches, local businesses and corporations take part by providing both labor and supplies for the projects.

Fourteen playhouses will be auctioned off at the Dreams Happen event. A 15th playhouse will be raffled off; raffle tickets are \$5 each. The houses are on display through June 12.

"These are playhouses that preserve real houses for neighbors in need," said Seana O'Shaughnessy, executive director of Rebuilding Together Peninsula, in a recent press release. "The proceeds from Dreams Happen significantly impact the lives of low-income families on the Peninsula."

The June 6 auction takes place in the Center Pavilion at Stanford Shopping Center, beginning at 6:30 p.m. A moonlight supper will be provided by the center's restaurants, and there will be dining and dancing under the stars. Tickets to the event are \$110.

Auction co-chairs are Rahela Abbas and Calla Griffith. To purchase tickets, call Rebuilding Together at 366-6597. ■

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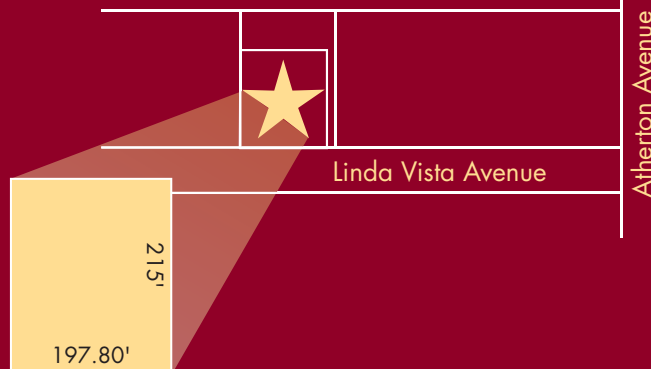

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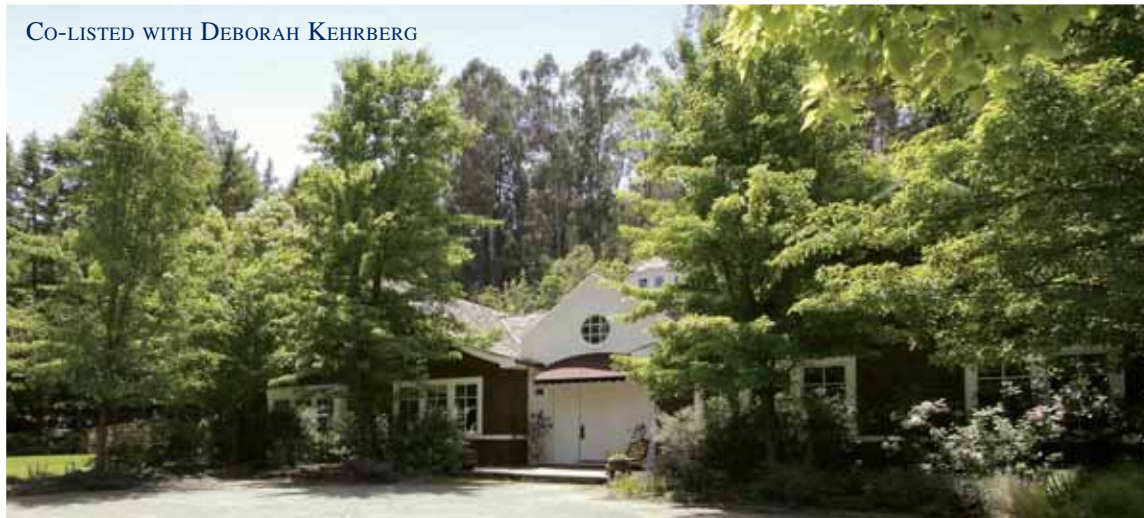

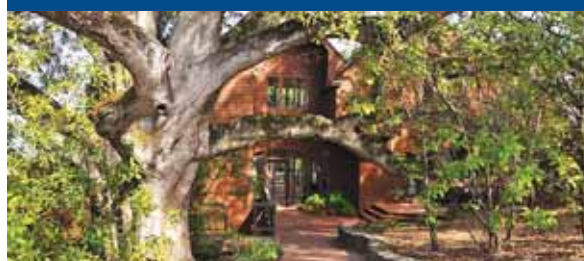
