# Menlo Park Celebrates 23rd Annual Connoisseurs' Marketplace

Presented by the Menlo Park Chamber of Commerce, large crowds are expected to pour onto the downtown streets for this vibrant celebration of visual, performing and culinary arts. Chaired by longtime Menlo Park resident and businessman Rick Ciardella, the 2009 festival will feature the return of artisan-produced specialty food in **Connoisseurs' Corner**, an organic, healthy and green-products showcase, and an infusion of new artists with fresh work and a variety of price points.

Festival-goers can sample and purchase artisan-produced edibles in **Connoisseurs' Corner**, located on Santa Cruz Avenue next to Fremont Park. For home-improvement ideas, check out product displays and chat with representatives from Heavenly Greens, Armstrong Painting, Clear View Screens, Southwest Greens, Cutco Cutlery, Danmer Custom Shutters, Gutter Helmet, Peninsula Window Fashions Gallery, BathFitter and Craftsmen's Guild.

**Festival eateries** will be serving up a world of flavorful fare, from Philly cheese steaks to spit-roasted gyros, spanakopita, chicken and sausage jambalaya, and spicy crawfish étouffée. Try barbecued oysters or Salvadoran pupusas for an international dining experience. Complementing the food will be a selection of wines, margaritas, and micro-brewed beers.

The Menlo Park Police and Fire Departments will be setting up **community-safety exhibits** at the festival. The Police Department tent will offer computer fingerprinting for kids. The Menlo Park Fire Department will set up its emergency-preparedness trailer. Learn about the history of earthquakes and experience a quake — the trailer will shake just like the real thing. Both exhibits will be on Chestnut Street.

## Fine art, one-of-a-kind crafts

From glass vessels, to wearable art, clothing and jewelry to slate fountains and hand-carved wooden furniture, there is something for every aspect of home, garden and self-decoration at Connoisseurs' Marketplace:

Metal sculptures, hand-painted tiles, vibrant paintings, one-of-a-kind jewelry, recycled metal work, unique embroidery wall hangings, chic wearables, handmade quilts, hand-thrown ceramic pieces and photography.

### Wearable art

Jeweler Marion Hunziker-Larsen combines fiber techniques like micro macramé knotting, with semi-precious gemstones, fossils and crystals. Barbara Ramos creates earrings, brooches and necklaces using a combination of fabric painting, collage and other techniques.

Diane Wat's fun and colorful hand-painted T-shirts capture the personalities of dogs, cats and other animals.

Jeannie Haydon creates detailed and textured geometric jewelry.

### Sculpture and mixed media

Justine Tot Tatarsky's painted tiles reflect a montage of styles, from cubism to surrealism to folk art.

Artist Ilona Hindt from Los Altos creates tiny, whimsical sculptures out of raw unspun wool in a process known as needle felting. Hindt's sculptures, from puppies to mermaids, range from 1 1/2 inches to nine inches tall.

Yan Inlow's hand-embroidered artwork combines a sense of Japanese style with Chinese embroidery technique.

Shirley Robles' whimsical ceramic sculptures include frogs, cats, rabbits, suns, moons and faces.

### Functional art

Beautiful, heirloom-quality dolls or puppets from Beth Karpas can change into something else, such as Little Bo Peep changing into her sheep.

Julia Mae's high-quality, hand-crafted wood products bring country charm to the kitchen.

Steven Andersen uses clear Western red cedar to create Adirondack chairs, glider benches, tables, chairs, planter boxes, trellises.

Hand-carved porcelain vases by Fox and Lois Garney are intricately carved in designs inspired by nature.

Catherine Reece decorates her cups, bowls and vases with butterflies, birds, leaves and dragonflies.

### Fine art

Michael Leu's colorful collection of paintings, lithographs, posters and cards showcase color, from abstracts to cats.

For John Gavrilis, the 4x5 view camera is his brush, photographing in large-print style the Grand Canyon and earth's natural beauty.

Tomas Mayberry's travel images capture everything from elaborately painted doorways of Mexico to the Greek islands

Tom Marlatt uses vibrant color and composition in non-object abstract oil paintings. ■

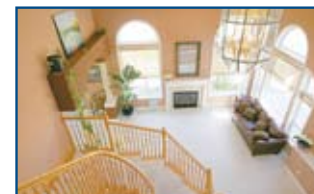

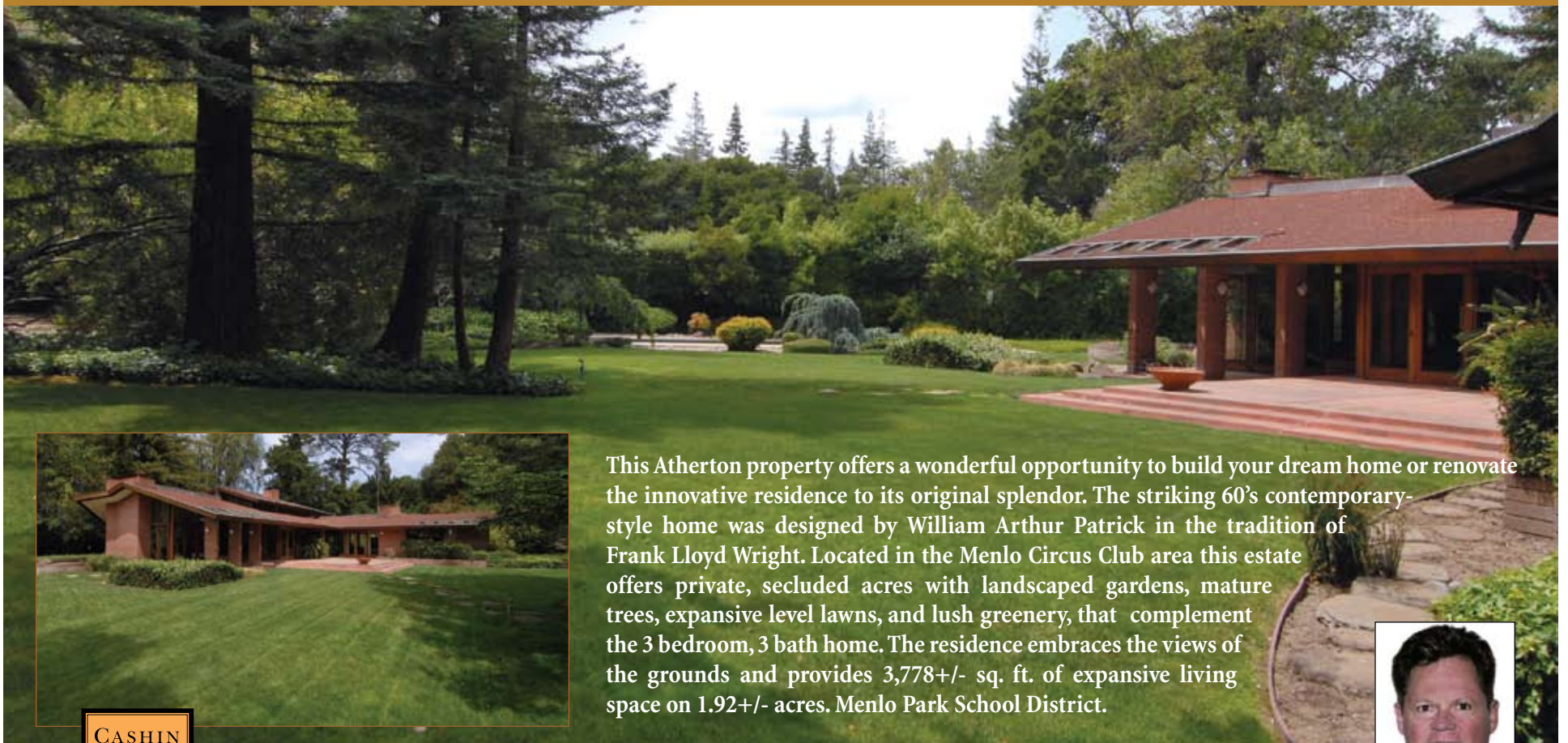

### From spicy jambalaya to tasty gyros, an al fresco feast

Menlo Park has its share of white-tablecloth establishments. But a few dollars can buy authentic New Orleans gumbo or slow-cooked Hawaiian pork at the open-air dining at Connoisseurs' Marketplace.

Here's an abbreviated menu of tastes:

\* New Orleans Catering gumbo, packed with seafood; jambalaya loaded with chicken, sausage and spice. Spicy crawfish étouffée, blackened and fried shrimp and red beans with rice.

\* B Food International Greek-style gyros, with seasoned lamb cooked on a spit and a tangy cucumber-yogurt sauce. And spanakopita—filo dough, feta cheese and spinach. For American food lovers, they offer Philly cheese steaks.

\* Kauai Abreu Ohana's Kalua slow-cooked shredded pork; teriyaki beef sliced paper thin and seasoned with homemade, low-sodium teriyaki sauce; subtly-smoky teriyaki chicken.

\* Aroma Catering offers crispy fried calamari with cilantro-lime sauce, barbecued oysters and crab cakes. There are also tri-tip sandwiches, smoked turkey legs and garlic fries.

\* California Gourmet features super chicken and pork kabobs or chicken teriyaki in a rice bowl or sandwich.

\* Lockeford Meat and Sausage serves German-

style smoked bratwurst, a garlic-scented pork-beef blend served with onions and sauerkraut on a hoagie.

\* The Menlo Park Lions Club offers all-beef hot dogs or smoked pork Polish dogs.

\* Sweet Delights sells hand-dipped corn dogs, and turkey or salmon burgers. For vegetarians, there are Portobello mushroom veggie burgers, deep-fried zucchini and artichoke hearts. Try Belgian fries—twice cooked for extra crispiness and served with garlic, jalapeño, cilantro and Parmesan cheese sauce. For sweet-tooths, there are funnel cakes to order, topped with fresh fruit, ice cream and whipped cream.

\* The Tamale Factory, a new vendor at the festival, showcases classic Mexican fare with subtly spiced pork and chicken tamales and beef or chicken asada tacos with rice and beans.

\* Main Street Food Concessions makes hand-made Salvadoran pupusas, fish tacos, Greek gyros, Caesar salad and garlic fries.

\* Sonoma Teriyaki cooks up grilled chicken marinated in garlic, ginger and soy sauce; steamed rice with vegetables, vegetarian fried rice, chow mein, or steamed rice with teriyaki vegetables.

\* Ear-Good Corn cooks up just-roasted corn or piping hot baked potatoes or yams.

\* Suitcase Ron's Kettlecorn offers fresh-popped popcorn.

\* Barrett's has hand-shaken lemonade.

\* Kurlander Soft Serve offers classics such as chocolate and strawberry and more fanciful piña colada, creamsicle and blue goo.

\* The Margarita King offers margaritas in many variations.

\* Beer lovers can try an assortment of brews: Sam Adams Summer Ale, Sam Adams Boston Lager, Blue Moon Belgian White and Coors Light. ■

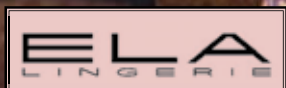
