Summer games

Thousands of kids head for camps where they can design — or redesign — computer games

On a typical, sunny day at Stanford University, kids sit at their desktop computers, fidgeting in their seats, as they anxiously await instructions from their counselors.

Ranging in age from 7 to 18, they are eager to put the skills they've learned at tech camp into practice. Finally, once the counselor gives them permission, the students turn to face their computer screens, open the video games they've been working on all week, and continue to "mod" — or modify — the original designs.

Throughout this summer, a total of about 2,000 students attended the camps, conducted at Stanford by a private company, iD Tech Camps. (The "iD" stands for internal drive.) Each five-day camp hosts approximately 250 kids.

In business since 1999, the company holds the tech camps at more than 60 universities in the U.S. and Canada, a spokesperson said.

Students take a single course during a five-day camp session, and are placed in a course based on age and level of interest. The most popular courses are gaming, both 2D and 3D, says marketing vice president Karen Thurm Safran. Other courses focus on such subjects as programming, Web design, robotics, and digital video editing.

A five-day camp costs \$779, or \$1,199 if the campers stay overnight. Many kids return to take several five-day courses over the summer, she says.

Kids don't have to have technology experience to come to the camps, but only teens are allowed to take the more advanced classes in programming and gaming. A programming academy is a two-week, overnight course that teaches advanced coding techniques, Ms. Thurm Safran says. Students create programs that they debut to NASA researchers or personnel from a Silicon Valley company.

At a gaming academy, students use the skills they acquire to design a 3D video game that can be played on their own Xbox 360 or a PC. Students also tour a gaming studio to see how the

The flock includes: Squeaky, Roxy, Peanut, Sugar, Spice, Biscuits, Gravy, Charcoal, Lola, Jezebel, Sugarpuff, Fifi, Tiffany, Penny, LaFawnduh, (from Napoleon Dynamite), Charlie, Katrina, Rolla, Cupcake, Goldie, Ruby, Cornelia Marie (named after one of the boats on the Deadliest Catch), Shasta and Ophelia.

They come in all shapes and colors and breeds: Ameraucana, American Game Bantam, Booted Bantam, Cochin, Cornish, Buff Orpington, Rhode Island Red, Silkie, Wyandotte, and Barred Rock.


The cartons of eggs Jeanine provides to her friends and family are unique. The eggs come in blue, green, the tra-

Elizabeth's 'Pampered Petz'

Eleven-year-old animal lover finds a way to keep busy this summer

This summer, 11-year-old Elizabeth Chadwick of Atherton channeled her love for animals into a summer job.

Elizabeth has always wanted pets of her own but has been unable to convince her parents to let her get a pet. Her parents also love animals but felt that they were not ready to make a commitment to a full-time pet.

So, as summer was approaching, Elizabeth found a way to be around pets and make some money as well. Instead of spending her summer at the various local summer camps, she approached her family with the idea of starting her own business, which would involve taking care of other people's pets.

Her parents, Mary and George Chadwick, were impressed with her business plan and helped her put her dream into motion.

Elizabeth sent out fliers to friends and neighbors. Soon she was flooded with business. She had pets coming from Atherton, Redwood City and Menlo Park.

Among her new clients was Angela Schauler, who was very busy planning her wedding and barely had time for her two pet guinea pigs, Pearl and Amber, which can usually be found in her third-grade classroom at St. Raymond Catholic School in Menlo Park.

Elizabeth stepped in by taking the guineas to her home and caring for them. She also bought all of the supplies Pearl and Amber needed.

Her business, Pampered Petz, has provided services for dogs, cats and, most recently, a cockatoo. What I found so unique about Pampered Petz is that Elizabeth takes photos of the animals while they are under her care and she e-mails the photos to the owners to give them a sense of comfort when they see that their pets are happy and in good hands.

Pampered Petz is great for pet owners who are going away for a day or two; kennels are very hard for some animals or for unique pets that cannot be left at kennels.

Pampered Petz is also great service for people who work and need someone to take their dogs for a walk or just come and check up on them during the day.

Elizabeth's various tasks include walking dogs, feeding the animals, going from house to house to clean animal cages, and, of course, playing with the pets.

After each visit, Elizabeth writes down which days she has taken care of them, what she has bought for them to satisfy their needs, and how long she spends with them. She uses this information for her billings and to inform the owners of anything out of the ordinary in their pet's behavior.

Elizabeth does all the work, although her parents drive her to the homes and pet shops.

All animals are accepted by Pampered Petz. As soon as Elizabeth accepts a pet, she thoroughly researches the type of animal she will be caring for. She looks forward to someday caring for turtles, chickens and maybe some fish.

I know one of the first things my mother asked our family when we decided to raise chickens was, "Who is going to take care of them when we are away?" Now I have the answer: "Pampered Petz!"

Pampered Petz has kept Elizabeth very busy all summer. It is almost like working a full-time job, but Elizabeth doesn't mind.

"This gives me the opportunity to be around all the different varieties of animals because I have never had many animals," she says. "They all have their own personalities. It's like a treat for me. It doesn't seem like a job."

I could see from the enthusiasm in her face that Elizabeth loves animals and she is very devoted to her job. Elizabeth plans on donating 20 percent of her earnings to charities involved in aiding homeless animals, such as "Pets In Need" in Redwood City.

Now that summer is coming to an end, Elizabeth is going to wind down her business so her

professionals work.

The tech camp maintains a 6-1 student-teacher ratio, Ms. Thurm Safran says. At Stanford, around 500 staff members were hired for the summer sessions, including college students, teachers and professionals.

Jonathan Taylor, a 10-year-old camper from Woodside, says that one of the best parts of the camp is the quality of the instructors. "I feel like I can take what I learn here and use it outside of camp in real-life situations," he says.

The premise of the camp, says Ms. Thurm Safran, "is to engage students in technology, by allowing them to use products that the professionals use." One of the main goals, she says, is for students to realize they can turn their interest in technology into a career.

Alexander Summers, a 12-year-old camper from Menlo Park, says he enjoys the

diversity of the courses. "I feel like I could use these skills to get a job someday."

Kes Rushing, a 14-year-old boy from Woodside, has been coming to the summer camps since 2005. "I've always been interested in technology, so I thought this sounded really fun," he says.

His favorite class is called "Game Modding: Unreal Tournament 3," where he can alter aspects of one of his favorite games.

The camp isn't entirely sedentary. Kids take occasional breaks from their computers and play outdoor games such as Ultimate Frisbee, capture-the-flag, and soccer.

Only about 15 percent of the campers are girls. "We are making an effort to reach out to more girls, and to show them that they, too, can play a part in the future of the technology industry," Ms. Thurm Safran says. ■

ditional white, and shades of brown, from chocolate to tan; in sizes from petite (the bantams) to extra large, with bright yellow yolks.

The birds also share their coop and yard with a couple of rabbits and a friendly mixed-breed dog. They keep the garden free of slugs, snails, spiders and most bugs.

When Jeannine arrives home from her job at Genentech, the chickens flock to greet her. If she sits down with a bag of bread crusts the chickens climb on her lap and shoulders to jostle for a bite. She calls them by name, and they cluck softly back.

Just how much does Jeannine love her chickens? So much that, more than once, she has given a

chicken that fell into her swimming pool cardio-pulmonary resuscitation — mouth to beak. Sadly, the fowl did not survive.

Jeanine posts “Chicken of the Day” photos and “Chicken Fact of the Day” on her Facebook site, sharing insights such as this: “A hen will turn her eggs over 50 times a day to make sure that the yolk does not stick to the shell. That’s if they are expecting ... a baby chicken that is. Most hens will not sit on eggs unless they are broody.”

“They relax me,” Jeannine says of her pets. “They are really entertaining, watching them interact with each other and their young.”

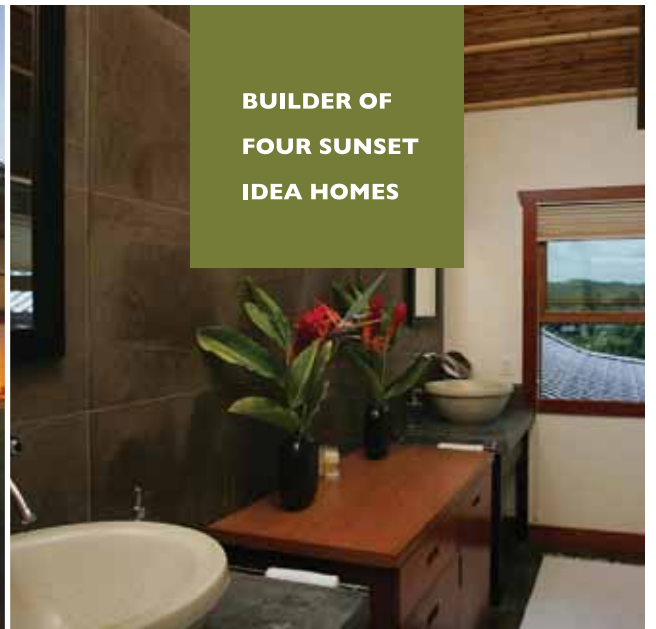

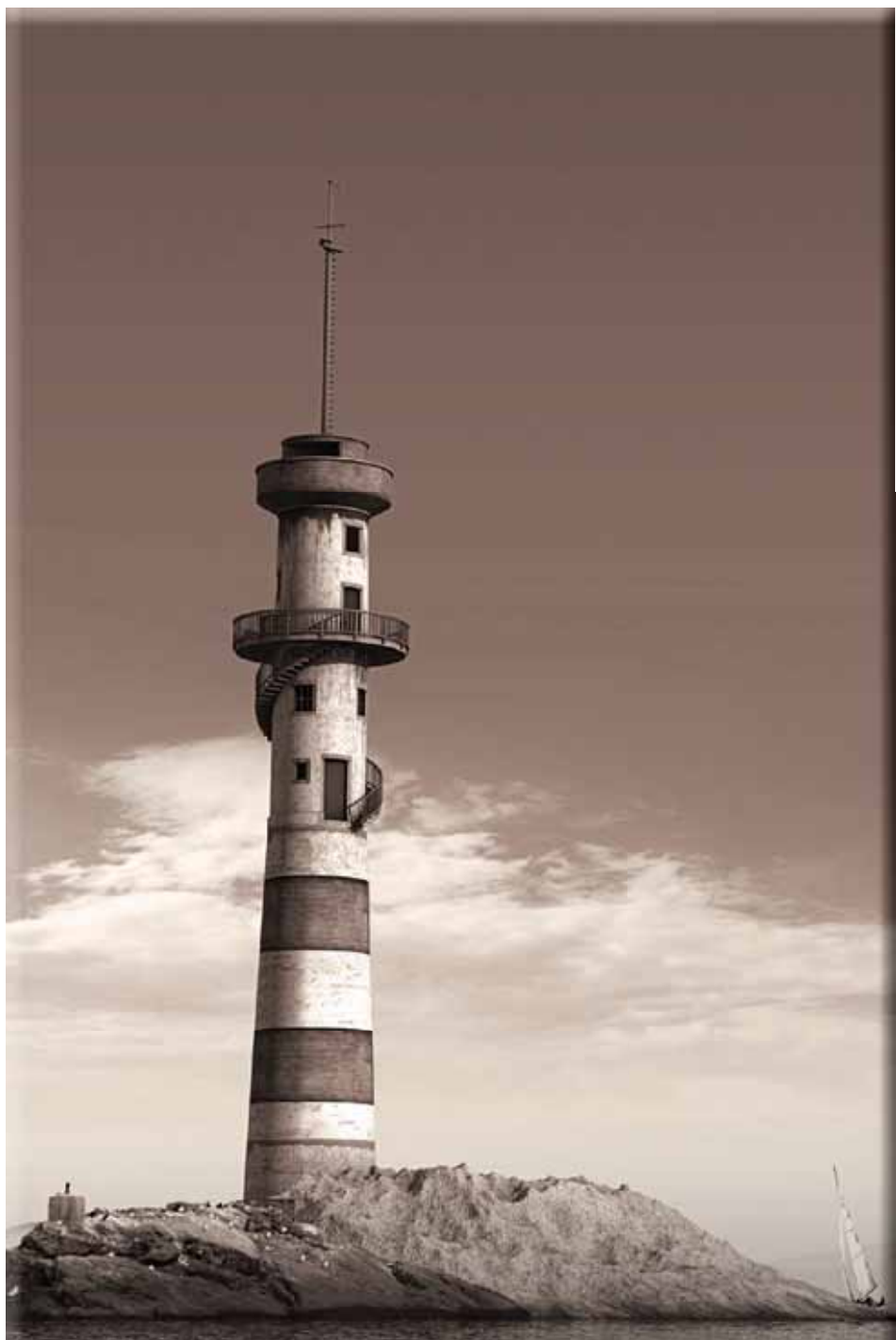
