WOODSIDE HIGH GRADS TAKE FLIGHT



Two speeches graced the spring air on June 8 at the football field at Woodside High School. Friends and family of some 365 seniors gathered to celebrate the graduation of the class of 2012.

In "The Morphing Process," Elena Turkalj compared the caterpillar-to-butterfly transition to that of freshman to senior, observers said. Some minutes later, under the title "Wordside," 20 valedictorians remembered utterances freighted with meaning: "SAT," "major," "career" and, last but not least, "We out," or, less colloquially, "We're going now. Thanks for the memories."

The senior gift to the school was a life-size bronze statue of a wildcat to be placed in the traffic circle in front of the administration building. "It will be very beautiful," Principal David Reilly said in an email.

In his address, Mr. Reilly spoke of what teachers and staff know about teenagers.

"We know teen spirit," he said, "a spirit best illustrated by the bird in the egg. In order for the bird to hatch from the egg, it must kick through the walls of infancy.

Some of you graduates are outside the egg already; some of you are soon to emerge. The best advice I can give, twenty years further down the road from you all, is to be guided by your questions, and remember Icarus."

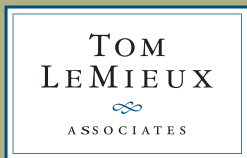
